### CONFERENCES & SUMMITS

- **9th India Mobile Congress (IMC) 2025**
- ✓ The theme of 9th India Mobile Congress (IMC) 2025 is 'Innovate to Transform'.



- ✓ IMC 2025 will be held from October 8–11 at Yashobhoomi Convention Centre, New Delhi.
- ✓ The event will showcase 1,000+ tech use cases in 5G, 6G, AI, IoT, electronics manufacturing, and green tech. ASPIRE, the agship startup program launched in 2023, will engage over 500 startups and connect them with over 300 investors, incubators, accelerators, and VCs for mentorship, live pitching sessions, and networking.

### SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY & ENVIRONMENT

- **Bharat Forecasting System**
- ✓ Union Minister of Earth Sciences Dr. Jitendra Singh launched the Bharat Forecasting System, BFS, in New Delhi.



- ✓ Developed by the Pune-based Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology, the Bharat Forecasting System will provide forecasts with a 6-kilometer resolution-the highest in the world-which will allow the meteorological department to predict small-scale weather features more accurately.
- ✓ The system will boost monsoon tracking, aviation, cyclone and disaster management, agriculture, waterways, defence, and flood forecasting.

## REPORT

- **India's Coastline Length Updated to 11,099 km, up from 7,516.6 km**
- ✓ The Ministry of Home Affairs, in its 2023–24 report, updated India's coastline length.



- ✓ Previous Length: 7,516.6 km (based on 1970s maps at 1:4,500,000 scale).
- ✓ Revised Length: 11,098.8 km (as of Dec 2024).
- ✓ States Involved: 11 coastal States + 2 UTs (Andaman & Nicobar, Lakshadweep).
- ✓ Longest coastline among Indian states — Gujarat (~1,600 km).

## IMPORTANT DAYS

- **World Football Day – May 25**
- ✓ In a historic and celebratory move, the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) has declared 25th May as World Football Day.



- ✓ The decision, adopted unanimously on 7 May 2024, commemorates the centenary of football's global representation during the 1924 Paris Summer Olympics.
- ✓ The resolution, introduced by Libya's ambassador Taher El-Sonni, acknowledges the cultural, social, and unifying power of the world's most popular sport — football.
