TAMIL NADU

➤ ‘Nalam Kakkum Stalin’ Camps

- ✓ Chief Minister M.K. Stalin on Thursday appealed to the public and elected representatives to take part in the camps to be organised under the ‘Nalam Kakkum Stalin’ programme.



- ✓ A total of 1,256 camps would be organised in all 38 districts of the State under the programme that is scheduled to be launched by the Chief Minister in Chennai on August 2.
- ✓ The camps would offer a range of medical services to the people.

SCHEMES

➤ Tamil Nadu State Policy for Transgender Persons, 2025

- ✓ Chief Minister M.K. Stalin on Thursday released the Tamil Nadu State Policy for Transgender Persons, 2025.



- ✓ The policy said the State would take steps to amend the Hindu Succession Act and the Indian Succession Act, among other laws, to ensure the right to inheritance for transgender and intersex persons.
- ✓ “The State will initiate action to ensure that laws against gender-based violence by family members, intimate partners, and others are implemented effectively”.
- ✓ The policy said the State would accord preference to transgender and intersex persons in affordable housing schemes and provision of free house site pattas.

➤ **World Lung Cancer Day – August 01**

- ✓ World Lung Cancer Day is observed every year on August 1.



- ✓ The day was established in 2012 by the Forum of International Respiratory Societies (FIRS) along with other health organisations.
- ✓ Theme: Stronger Together: United for Lung Cancer Awareness.
- ✓ It aims to raise awareness about lung cancer.

➤ **World Wide Web Day – August 01**

- ✓ World Wide Web Day 2025, observed on August 01, celebrates the transformative power of the World Wide Web while addressing challenges like the digital divide, cyber threats, and privacy concerns.



- ✓ With the theme “Empowering the Future: Building an Inclusive, Safe, and Open Web,” the day focuses on digital inclusion, ethical AI use, and universal access.

- ✓ World Breastfeeding Week 2025, celebrated from August 1 to 7, emphasizes the theme “Prioritise Breastfeeding: Create Sustainable Support Systems.”
