TAMIL NADU

- > Kalaignar Magalir Urimai Thogai Scheme in Tamil Nadu
- ✓ Introduced in September 2023, the scheme is aimed at recognising women for doing the domestic work in their household that has historically fallen on the women's shoulders.



- ✓ The government gives ₹1,000 a month to women heads of families earning less than ₹2.5 lakh a year.
- ✓ Since then, many other States have followed suit. Among them are Karnataka, Maharashtra, and Jharkhand.

- ✓ Indian Police Foundation(IPF) entered a memorandum of understanding with Tamil Nadu Police on Friday for conducting internal police reforms projects and undertaking other research/capacity building activities with Tamil Nadu police.

- India's First Fully Digitally Literate State
- ✓ Kerala has been declared India's first fully digitally literate state, completing Phase I of the Digi Kerala project, which trained over 21.87 lakh people in basic digital skills, including senior citizens.



✓ Through a grassroots, inclusive model, the state bridged the digital divide, empowering citizens for e-governance, digital democracy, and socio-economic resilience, and set a model for Digital India by prioritizing people-centric digital empowerment over infrastructure alone.

- ✓ India celebrates National Space Day 2025 on August 23 to mark the second anniversary of Chandrayaan-3's historic soft landing near the Moon's South Pole.



- ✓ The day honours ISRO's remarkable achievements—from Aryabhatta to the upcoming Gaganyaan mission.
- ✓ The theme, "Aryabhatta to Gaganyaan: Ancient Wisdom to Infinite Possibilities," reflects India's blend of ancient astronomy and modern technology as the nation aims for future milestones like an Indian space station by 2035 and crew missions to the Moon by 2040.
