- **Geographical Indication tag sought for Kanniyakumari Nannari**
- ✓ In the lush landscapes of Kanniyakumari district grows *Nannari* — a herb treasured for generations by local communities, renowned for its cooling properties and revered as a traditional cure for mouth ulcers.



- ✓ Now, the Tamil Nadu Malaivaazh Makkal Sangam, Kulasekaram, along with the Patent Information Centre of the Tamil Nadu State Council for Science and Technology, has sought a Geographical Indication (GI) tag for *Kanniyakumari Nannari*, to preserve its identity and promote its unique regional value.

- ✓ The report is based on data from 757 villages across five states, chosen to represent India's diverse social and cultural contexts.
