### **TAMIL NADU**

- Cauvery Delta Region Expansion
- ✓ The Tamil Nadu government has added 38 revenue villages to the Srimushnam taluk in the Cauvery delta region.



- ✓ These villages were earlier part of Kattumannarkoil taluk, which was later divided into separate administrative units.
- ✓ A Government Order (G.O.) from the Water Resources Department confirmed the inclusion.

➤ Military Exercise SURYAKIRAN-XIX

✓ The 19th India—Nepal joint military exercise, SURYAKIRAN-XIX 2025, commenced on November 25, 2025, in Pithoragarh, Uttarakhand, running until December 8, 2025.



✓ Both countries have deployed 334 personnel each (Indian Army – ASSAM Regiment; Nepal Army – DEVI DATTA Regiment) to enhance operational coordination and regional defence cooperation.

### **SPORTS**


- India Clinches Women's Kabaddi World Cup
- ✓ India's women's kabaddi team won the Women's Kabaddi World Cup 2025, defeating Chinese Taipei 35–28 in Dhaka, Bangladesh, successfully defending their title.



✓ Led by Captain Ritu Negi and Vice-Captain Pushpa Rana, with standout performances from Sanju Devi, Champa Thakur, Bhawna Thakur, and Sakshi Sharma, India showcased strong defense, tactical raids, and disciplined gameplay.

## **IMPORTANT DAYS**


- National Milk Day November 26
- ✓ On Nov 26, 2025, India celebrated National Milk Day to honour Dr. Verghese Kurien, the Father of the White Revolution, highlighting India's transformation into the world's largest milk producer, contributing nearly 25% of global output.



✓ The day recognised achievements in dairy production, livestock care, and initiatives like the Rashtriya Gokul Mission for conservation and improvement of indigenous breeds.

#### ➤ National Constitution Day – November 26

✓ National Constitution Day (Samvidhan Divas) is observed annually on 26 November to commemorate the adoption of the Indian Constitution in 1949.



- ✓ On Constitution Day 2025, India marked 75 years since this historic event, honouring the efforts of the Constituent Assembly and especially Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, Chairman of the Drafting Committee.
- ✓ The day promotes constitutional literacy, emphasizing fundamental rights.
