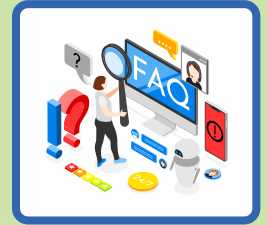

Why Appollo Study Centre is Unique?

- ◆ Appollo Study Centre engages Aspirants in Coaching and Teaching up to the TNPSC Examination.
- ◆ Even after completing the Teaching Syllabus, the Institute engages Aspirants in a Scheduled Test cum discussion program till Examination.

Infrastructure of the Class

- ◆ State of Art Infrastructure, Well Equipped, Well Maintained and Digitalized Air-Conditioned class rooms are provided to the Aspirants.
- ◆ Technologically upgraded classrooms to facilitate Interactive Teaching and Learning Experience through Advanced Tools and Techniques.

Why Classes are conducted only 3 days a week.

- ◆ Competitive Examination involves strong and consistent initiation in terms of Continuous Reading, Understanding, Underlining, and connecting with the Past Question Papers, Taking Notes, Continuous Revision and Practising Test etc.
- ◆ 80 – 20 Rule
Aspirants have to take part active role in preparation by Taking Notes, referring Standard Text Books, Working out Practice Questions, Homework etc. Along with these a separate Study Plane will also be given to Aspirants as daily, weekly and monthly tasks.
To fulfill all these, Classes are restricted only to three days a week and the remaining four days are dedicated for Coaching.
i.e. 80% Coaching & 20% Teaching.

Frequency of Tests

- ◆ As testing tools are vital for the success of the Aspirants, it has been continuously and consistently reviewed, updated and strengthened by the Institute since the last 25 years.
- ◆ Initially, Class Tests are organized once in a week followed by Spot Tests and Monthly Consolidated Test.
- ◆ Later Aspirants are linked with Test Batches till Examination.

Whether Study Hall Access is available at Preliminary Exam Level

- ◆ Yes, we do provide extended study hall facility after identifying the aspirants who are comprehensively and continuously preparing for the examination very seriously and committed.
- ◆ This process is also extended to the aspirants based on the Assessment Test done by the Director in-person.

Apart from Study Material provided by our Institute whether any other Materials are suggested at Preliminary Exam Level

- ◆ Yes, we recommend certain guides and Text Books along with the Page Numbers as the Additional Source for the Examination.
- ◆ The soft copy of the entire School book is provided to the aspirants at the time of enrolment.
- ◆ Monthly Current Affairs e-Material is provided to the Aspirants both in Tamil and English.
- ◆ The Reference Hall provides access to all relevant course materials.

Whether remedial Class available for Students who do not perform well in weekly Test that is conducted by the Institute for regular batch.

- ◆ The Director in-person will organize mentoring session for all the aspirants regarding how to crack the TNPSC Examination.
- ◆ A special attention program for specific subjects like Maths, Unit 8 & 9, is organized for weak Aspirants.

For Mental Ability – Any separate coaching is given apart from regular class.

- ◆ Special Mental Ability Session will be organized for weak students.

How about the evaluation of the answer script, how do they receive marks, any feedback session available for students to improve themselves?

- ◆ All objective type MCQ examinations are systematically evaluated by in-built OMR Machine and their scores are communicated to the Aspirants.
