TAMIL NADU

➤ Tamil Nadu Government – increases sub-quota in recruitments for Sportspersons to 3% on Oct 16, 2018 - from the present 2% announced on Aug 15, 2018




- ✓ Hon'ble Tamil Nadu Chief Minister, Edapaadi K Palaniswami announced the decision during a function in Chennai
- Chennai Corporation to launch a new 'App-based' Parking project on a pilot basis in the areas of Shanti Colony, Anna Nagar, Besant Nagar, and Marina Beach over the next three weeks



- ✓ It would eventually be extended to 471 roads across the city
- ✓ The new App will help two-wheeler and four-wheeler users to find parking spots closest to their destinations
- ✓ The system can also detect the vehicles in the no-parking zones
- Tamil Nadu Government appoints new additional advocate-general, C Emalias



- ✓ He was holding the post of additional public prosecutor currently and becomes the 11th additional advocate-general of the state
- ✓ In Tamil Nadu, the post of additional advocate-general was first created in the year 1996
- ✓ Senior advocate, TR Rajagopalan was the first additional advocate-general appointed to assist the then advocate-general, K V Venkatapathy
- ➤ Tamil Nadu Government appoints senior advocate, A Natarajan as the state public prosecutor
- ✓ The post has been lying vacant for the last one year
- ✓ He was having an experience of 40 years with specialization on the criminal side.
- > Tamil Nadu plans to upload 'People's Biodiversity Register' online
- ✓ It will be the first state in the country to make the inventory of valuable natural resources 'online'



- ✓ PBR will have an inventory of local plants, herbs, medicinal plants, wildlife, domesticated animals, pests, fodder crops and weeds
- ✓ Making an inventory of animals and plants is mandated by the National Biological Diversity Act of 2002
- ✓ So far 21 states have prepared the register.
- ✓ In the south, Karnataka tops the list with the preparation of 1,777 PBRs, followed by Kerala with 892 PBRs.
- √ Tamil Nadu has already began the process of preparing PBRs.
- V O Chidambaranar (VOC) Port, Tuticorin sets a record by handling a vessel of 229m length for the first time in its history
- ✓ The vessel, 'MV Zheng Jun', was carrying 74,962 tonnes of coal for Neyveli Thermal Power Limited (NTPL)
- ✓ The vessel was having a draft of 14m (distance between the waterline and bottom
 of the hull)
- ✓ The maximum draft handled so far by the port was 13.2m of the vessel MV Dionysus on June 20, 2018

SCHEMES

West Bengal – launches a new scheme, 'Khadya Sathi' – on the occasion of World food day



✓ The scheme intends to ensure food security to more than 8.5 crore people of the state

NATIONAL

➤ Government – launches 'Swasth Bharath Yatra', a national campaign on the occasion of World Food Day on October 16, 2018



- ✓ The campaign, led by Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI),
 highlights the importance of eating safe food and stay healthy
- ✓ Under it, a pan-India 'cycle rally' is organized to propagate a powerful message 'Eat Right India'
- ✓ In this rally, about 7,500 cyclists will participate in over 18,000 km travelling across six tracks through almost every state and UT over a period of 100 days
- ✓ The cyclathon will end in New Delhi on January 27, 2019

- Government signs MoU with Lady Irwin College for establishing 'ROSHNI'-Centre of Women Collectives-led social action
- ✓ The MoU was signed by 'The Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana National Rural Livelihood Mission' (DAY-NRLM) of the Ministry of Rural Development
- ✓ Roshni is technically and financially supported by the UNICEF India
- ✓ It will be located in the college's Department of Development Communication
- ✓ It is dedicated to spread awareness among women on aspects of health and nutrition
- ✓ DAY-NRLM aims to reach out to 8-10 crore rural poor household in a time bound manner till they come out of Poverty
- ✓ Roshni aims to work with women collectives for social action on Food, Health, Nutrition and WASH interventions through self-help groups
- ✓ It will learn from Swabhimaan, a collaborative initiative of DAY- NRLM and UNICEF India, launched in 2016
- ✓ Swabhimaan was started in 5 poorest DAY-NRLM resource blocks in 4 districts of 3 Indian states Bihar, Chhattisgarh and Odisha, catering to women's health and nutrition
- ✓ The 'Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana National Rural Livelihood Mission' was launched as the Aajeevika National Rural Livelihoods Mission (NRLM) in 2011

- Government sets up a hi-tech 'Central Warehouse' of 'Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana' (PMBJP) at Bilaspur, Gurugram - to facilitate distribution of Jan Aushadhi medicines
- ✓ The warehouse was developed by the 'Bureau of Pharma PSUs of India' (BPPI)
- ✓ It was inaugurated by Mansukh Mandaviya, Union Minister of State for Chemicals & Fertilizers



- ✓ He had also inaugurated the 'Digital Cash Management System' for the healthcare scheme, which will be implemented as a partnership between BPPI and Bank of Baroda
- ✓ The Bank of Baroda will also provide a loan to all PMBJP Kendras for purchasing medicines.
- ✓ Besides, the Minister also released the first edition of e-magazine of PMBJP "Jan Aushadhi Samvad" (September 2018 edition)
- ✓ Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana
- √ 'Jan Aushadhi' is a project launched by the Union Government in 2008 to provide quality medicines at affordable prices for all
- ✓ The first 'Jan Aushadhi Medical Store' was opened on November 25, 2008 at Amritsar in Punjab
- ✓ Currently, there are more than 4200 PMBJP Kendra functional in 34 states and union territories across India
- ✓ As a result, over 700 medicines and 154 surgical and consumables are available
 in the basket for sale
- Ministry of Women and Child Development clarifies that victims of child sexual abuse can file a complaint at any time irrespective of his or her present age – through POCSO e-Box
- ✓ The Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, 2012 came into force on November 14, 2012
- ✓ The Act was passed in the Indian Parliament in May 2012

- ➤ New Education Policy to be submitted by the Government before October 31, 2018
- ✓ It intends to reduce academic load and create more focus for sports, Mathematics and Indian Languages

- ✓ A new committee under former Isro chief, K Kasturirangan was constituted for the purpose in June 2017
- ✓ The current education policy was framed in 1986 and revised in 1992.
- √ The policy has been framed with a 20-year-vision (2020-2040)

INTERNATIONAL

- Canada becomes the 2nd country in the world to legalise the usage of Cannabis
- ✓ Medical usage of marijuana has been legal in Canada since 2001
- ✓ Cannabis, also known as Marijuana, is used as a psychoactive drug for medical or recreational purposes
- ✓ Earlier, Uruguay has legalized the use of Cannabis in 2013
- ✓ Countries that have legalized the medical use of cannabis include Australia, Canada, Chile, Colombia, Germany, Greece, Israel, Italy, the Netherlands, Peru, Poland, Sri Lanka and the United Kingdom

INDIA AND OTHER COUNTRIES

- India to set up 'UAE Plus', a special desk to facilitate investments from UAE
- ✓ The desk will also resolve any business issues between the two nations
- ✓ It would be established in Invest India, the National Investment Promotion Agency
 of India



- ✓ This was announced at the 6th meeting of UAE-India High-Level Joint Task Force on Investments in Mumbai
- ✓ The UAE is the tenth largest investor in India, with a FDI of \$1.05 billion

APPOINTMENTS

Sandeep Bakshi – to be appointed as the Managing Director (MD) and Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of ICICI Bank for a period of three years



- ✓ His elevation from the position of Chief Operating Officer, has been approved by the RBI
- ✓ Sandeep Bakshi joined the ICICI group in the year 1986
- ✓ He was appointed as the MD and CEO of ICICI Prudential Life Insurance Company on August 1, 2010
- ✓ He was appointed as the bank's COO in June 2018
- ✓ He replaces Chanda Kochhar, who had resigned on October 4, six months before her current tenure was about to end

Alia Bhatt, film actress – appointed as the Brand Ambassaor of 'Nokia' in India



✓ HMD Global, which designs and sells phones under the Nokia brand, announced the appointment

- Youth Olympics, Buenos Aires
- ✓ Suraj Panwar wins Silver in men's 5000m race walk event



- ✓ This is India's first athletics medal in this edition and third overall.
- ✓ Arjun (men's discus throw) and Durgesh Kumar (men's 400m hurdles) had won a silver each in the inaugural edition in 2010

INTERNATIONAL DAY

International day for the Eradication of Poverty – October 17



- ✓ The day intends to raise people's awareness of the need to eradicate poverty worldwide, particularly in developing countries
- ✓ The day is observed since 1993
- ✓ Theme 2018 'Coming together with those furthest behind to build an inclusive world of universal respect for human rights and dignity'

- ✓ This year marks 25th anniversary of the institution of this day, by UN General Assembly in December 1992 through its resolution 47/196
- ✓ This year also marks 70th anniversary of proclamation of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (December 10, 1948)

REPORT

Global Competitive Index 2018 – Released by World Economic Forum

- ✓ India has been ranked as the 58th most competitive economy in the world, with a jump of 5 places from 2017, having the largest gain among G20 economies
- ✓ On the list of 140 economies, the United States ranked at the first place, followed by Singapore and Germany at the second and the third positions respectively
