
Prime Minister – to launch "Main Nahin Hum" Portal and App on October 24, 2018



- ✓ The portal, which works on the theme "Self4Society", will enable IT professionals and organizations to put their efforts towards social causes in a single platform
- NABARD and Ayurvet Research Foundation signs MoU for integrated Agricultural and Rural development initiatives in Haryana
- ✓ National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) will tie up with Delhi based Ayurvet – to provide solutions for various developmental challenges faced in Haryana

- NASSCOM enters into partnership with Hiroshima Government for cocreating a 'Japan-India IT Corridor' in Hiroshima
- ✓ National Association of Software and Services Companies (NASSCOM) is the Indian IT industry's Apex body
- ✓ The project will be formally initiated by early 2019
- ✓ The initiative provides a gateway to the collaboration between Indian and Japanese IT & software companies
- Kendriya Vidyalaya and Navodaya Vidyalaya students to greet teachers and friends in 22 recognized Indian languages for 22 consecutive days beginning October 31, 2018
- ✓ The initiative is a part of a nationwide programme to celebrate the birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel
- ➤ Election Commission of India to ask the parties to submit Poll manifestos within 3 days of its publication
- ✓ This is a first of its kind directive by the Election Commission.
- ✓ It also asks the parties to refrain from announcing any promises that cannot be fulfilled
- ➢ Indian Railways to launch its 'UTS Mobile App' nationwide for buying 'Unreserved tickets online' from 1st November, 2018



- ✓ The scheme was launched in Mumbai in 2014 and later expanded to Delhi-Palwal and Chennai city
- ✓ As of now, the Railways has already implemented the scheme in 15 of its zones
 with the North east Frontier Railway and West Central Railway being the
 remaining two zones.
- ✓ UTS mobile app can be used to book train tickets and to buy platform tickets and monthly passes

- > India & China signs agreement on Internal security cooperation
- ✓ It is the 1st such agreement between the two neighbours



- ✓ Signatories
 - ✓ Rajnath Singh, Union Home Minister
 - ✓ Zhao Kezhi, State Councilor and Minister of Public Security, China

- A 6-member panel was set up to look into the resolution of Stressed Assets of Banks
- ✓ The committee includes
 - ✓ Janki Ballabh (former Chairman, State Bank of India)
 - ✓ MBN Rao (former Chairman & Managing Director, Canara Bank)
 - ✓ M Damodaran (former Chairman, SEBI)
 - ✓ HR Khan (former Deputy Governor, RBI)
 - ✓ A senior Tata Group executive with expertise in the power sector
 - ✓ A Bombay High Court Judge
- ✓ The appointment of the panel was earlier recommended by the Sunil Mehta (Non-Executive Chairman of Punjab National Bank) Committee on restructuring stressed assets

CONFERENCES & SUMMITS

➤ STAPCOR – 2018 – An International Conference on Status and Protection of Coral Reefs – begins at Bangaram Island, Union Territory of Lakshadweep



- ✓ The 3-day conference, starting on October 24, was inaugurated by Dr Harsh Vardhan, Union Minister of Environment, Forest and Climate Change
- ✓ About 150 delegates, both International and National, are participating in the event
- ✓ Theme "Reef for Life"
- ✓ It has to be recalled that International Coral Reef Initiative (ICRI) has declared year 2018 as 'International Year of the Reef'
- ✓ Great Barrier Reef, located in Coral Sea, off the coast of Queensland in north-east Australia is largest Coral reef in the world
- ✓ The major reef formations in India are restricted to Gulf of Mannar, Gulf of Kachchh, Andaman and Nicobar and Lakshadweep Islands
- ✓ Corals are often called "Rainforests of the sea"
- ✓ They occupy less than 0.1% of world's ocean area, but provides home for at least 25% of all marine species
- SIAL Paris Exhibition starts in Paris, France



- ✓ The 5-day expo, between October 21 and 25, is the world's largest Food innovation exhibition
- √ 45 Indian companies are participating in the exhibition with a special Indian pavilion set up by 'Trade Promotion Council of India' (TPCI)
- ✓ It is the world's leading exhibition of food service products with more than 7020 French and international exhibitors from 109 countries displaying their foodstuffs
- ✓ It was launched in 1964 in Paris and held thereafter in every 2 years
- ✓ The exhibition is famous for culinary demonstrations by famous chefs every day

SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY & ENVIRONMENT

- ➢ Indian scientists develop a Skin 'Gel' to prevent pesticides absorbed into the body
- ✓ It was developed by a team led by Dr. Praveen Kumar Vemula from the Institute for Stem Cell Biology and Regenerative Medicine, Bengaluru
- ✓ Active ingredients of the Pesticides are attached to 'Chitosan' (a substance found in the hard outer shells of crab and shrimp) so that they are not absorbed by the skin
- Physicists from Belarus discovers new drug 'Bedaquiline' to treat drugresistant Tuberculosis
- ✓ The trials of the drug has delivered a success rate of 80% and is hailed as the 'Game changer' in the treatment of TB

APPOINTMENTS

Government – appoints M Nageshwar Rao as the Director of the 'Central Bureau of Investigation' (CBI) with immediate effect



- ✓ He is presently working as Joint Director at the CBI
- ✓ Alok Verma, the incumbent Director of CBI was removed from his post on October 23, 2018
- ✓ Verma took over the post in 2016 for a period of 2 years and is due to retire in December 2018
- Suresh Nambath, Senior Journalist appointed as the next editor of 'The Hindu'



- ✓ He succeeds Mukund Padmanabhan, who has been the Editor since March 2016
- ✓ Nambath has been working with the newspaper for the last 22 years
- ✓ He was working as the National editor of 'The Hindu' since October 2015
- ✓ His appointment with be effective from March 1, 2019

Roshni Nadar Malhotra, Daughter of Shiv Nadar – appointed as Vice Chairman of the board of Directors of HCL Technologies



- ✓ HCL is the country's 3rd largest IT Company
- ✓ Shiv Nadar is the founder of the \$8.2 billion group, HCL Technologies
- ✓ Roshni, 36, is the current CEO and executive director of HCL Corporation, a holding company which controls HCL Tech, HCL Infosystems and HCL Healthcare
- ✓ She has also been a Non-executive Director of HCL Tech, a position she continues to hold since 2013
- > K N Radhakrishnan appointed as Director and CEO at TVS Motors for a period of five years commencing starting 23rd October, 2018



- ✓ He is an alumnus of IIT-Madras and Indian Institute of Management (IIM), Ahmedabad
- ✓ He started his career in Sundaram Clayton in 1986 as a Management Trainee and soon became the head of Business Planning and TQM for the group
- ✓ In 2004, he was promoted as executive VP of TVS Motor and in 2008 as its president
- ✓ Under his leadership TVS has become the 3rd largest selling two wheeler brand in India

- ✓ He is the fourteenth recipient of this award.
- ✓ The award will be presented to him by 'Seoul Peace Prize Foundation' at a later date
- ✓ PM Modi was chosen for the award among 1300 nominations
- ✓ The Seoul Peace Prize was instituted in the year 1990 to commemorate success
 of the 24th Olympic Games held in Seoul, South Korea
- ✓ The awardee receives a diploma, a plaque and honorarium of \$200,000
- ✓ The first recipient of the award is Juan Antonio Samaranch (Spain), former President of International Olympic Committee
- ✓ The previous notable winners of the award includes Kofi Annan (1998), Mohammad Yunus (2006), Ban Ki-moon (2012), Angela Merkel (2014), Denis Mukwege (2016) etc.,

Former Prime Minister, HD Deve Gowda – conferred with Maharshi Valmiki Jayanti Award – on the occasion of Valmiki Jayanti - in Vidhana Soudha, Bengaluru, Karnataka



- ✓ He is awarded for his contribution to the welfare of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes communities
- ✓ The award will be given by Karnataka Chief Minister HD Kumaraswamy
- ✓ HD Deve Gowda served as the 11th Prime Minister of India from June 1, 1996 to April 21, 1997
- ✓ He was also the 14th Chief Minister of Karnataka from 1994 to 1996
- ➤ Miss Deaf Asia 2018, Prague
- ✓ Nishtha Dudeja (India) wins the Miss Deaf Asia 2018 Pageant



- ✓ She is the first Indian to have won any title at the Miss Deaf World Pageant
- ✓ Prior to this title, Nishtha had also won the Miss Deaf India title on February 26, 2018 in Jaipur
- ✓ She is the brand ambassador for Sivantos India Pvt Ltd. (Formerly Siemens hearing Instruments Pvt Ltd.), the World's leading brand of hearing aids
- She had also participated in Deaflympics 2013 (held in Sofia, Bulgaria), World Deaf Tennis Championship 2015 (held in Nottingham, UK) and Deaflympics 2017 (held in Samsun, Turkey)
- ➤ Athletics Federation of India to be awarded the FICCI (Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry) India Sports Awards 2018
- ✓ The award will be in the category of Best National Sports Federation (NSF).
- ✓ The Jury for the awards was chaired by Justice (Retd) Mukul Mudgal

Baba Indrajith – appointed as Tamil Nadu captain for the 2018-19 Ranji Trophy season



- ✓ He replaces Abhinav Mukund, who led Tamil Nadu last season
- > 3rd Elite Men's National Boxing Championship to be held in Pune between Oct 27 and Nov 2, 2018
- ✓ It will have the participation of nearly 360 Boxers in 10 Categories from 36 teams
 of various States/Services
- ✓ Boxing Federation of India will shortlist boxers for National Camps and next year's Olympic Qualifying Tournaments based on this event
- ✓ It is organised by Army Sports Institute, Pune under the aegis of Services Sports
 Control Board

- ✓ India tops Google Play Store downloads in last 7 years- between January 2012 and August 2018
- ✓ On an annual basis, India became the No. 1 downloader from Google Play Store in 2016
- ✓ The US and Brazil were ahead of India before 2016
- ✓ The country is No. 2 when both Google Play Store and Apple iOS Store downloads are taken into account, with China leading the rankings
- ✓ India beat the US to take the second slot in 2017, even though China and the US are big Apple markets, unlike India

- ✓ Japan ranks the highest, spending a whopping \$25.1 billion, followed by US (\$19.3 billion)
- ✓ India is not in the top 10 in the rankings of Purchases
- ✓ As per the report, Indians don't spend much money on apps they prefer free apps and avoid in-app purchases
- ✓ App Installations
- ✓ Australians topped the list, installing on average as many as 103 apps and using 39 apps actively each month
- ✓ They are followed by Americans, who install 102 apps and use 37 actively
- ✓ South Koreans are third on the list, who install 100 apps and use 40 actively
- ✓ India ranks at 11th place with an average download of 62 apps on their mobiles and active use of 35 apps

INTERNATIONAL DAY

Valmiki Jayanthi (Pargat Diwas) – October 24



- √ Valmiki is revered as the first poet of Sanskrit literature
- ✓ He is the author of the epic Ramayana which consists of 24,000 verses and 7 cantos (Kandas) including the Uttara canto
- √ Valmiki is also known as Maharishi Valmiki and considered as the Adi Kavi, the
 first poet of Sanskrit language


- ✓ As per Hindu lunar calendar, his Jayanti is celebrated on Ashwin Purnima (full moon night in the Hindu month of Ashwina)
- ✓ The day is also referred to as Pragat Diwas
- ✓ The biggest temple of Rishi Valmiki 'The Maharishi Valmiki temple' is in Thiruvanmiyur in Chennai
- ✓ It is believed to be 1300 years old
- ✓ It is located on the East Coast Road and the area is called 'Valmiki Nagar'
- ✓ It is believed that after writing Epic Ramayana, Maharishi Valmiki rested at the spot and later 'The Maharishi Valmiki temple' was built
- ✓ Each year, the Brahmatosavam festival is celebrated in the month of March

World Polio Day – October 24



- ✓ The day is observed globally to generate awareness for the eradication of polio, as well as to honour the efforts of employees of World Health Organization (WHO) and other organisations committed to the cause
- ✓ The occasion commemorates the birth of American medical researcher and virologist Jonas Salk, who discovered the first successful vaccine (IPV) for poliomyelitis or polio in 1955
- ✓ Theme 2018 'End Polio Now'
- ✓ Polio is a highly infectious viral disease, which mainly affects young children
- ✓ It has no cure but can be prevented through immunization
- ✓ As per WHO, 'Global Polio Eradication Initiative' (Established in 1988) has eradicated Polio by 99%
- ✓ As of today, only 3 countries in the world, Pakistan, Afghanistan and Nigeria have still reported the disease
- √ There are 2 forms of vaccine available to eradicate polio oral polio vaccine (OPV) and inactivated polio vaccine (IPV)
- ✓ OPV was developed by Albert Sabin
- ✓ India received Polio-free certification along with the entire South-East Asia Region of WHO (World Health Organisation) on 27th March 2014 by WHO

United Nations Day – October 24



- ✓ The day marks the anniversary of UN Charter's entry into force in 1945
- ✓ It is celebrated on October 24 since 1948
- ✓ In 1971, United Nations General Assembly recommended this day to be observed by Member States as a public holiday
- ✓ Theme 2018 "Traditions of Peace and Non-violence"
- ➤ World Development Information Day October 24



- ✓ On 24 October 1970, the International Development Strategy for the 2nd United Nations Development Decade was adopted
- ✓ The day is observed since 1972, coinciding with the United Nations day
- ✓ The day highlights development problems and the need to strengthen international cooperation to solve them
