

Depression turns cyclonic storm; 'Maha' may intensify further

A depression that developed in the Comorin Sea has rapidly intensified into a cyclonic storm, named 'Maha', with a speed of 25 km per hour.

It lies centered over Lakshadweep and the adjoining southeast Arabian Sea and the Maldives area, about 130 km northeast of Minicoy, 130 km southeast of Kavaratti in Lakshadweep and 320 km west-northwest of Thiruvananthapuram. It is likely to intensify further into a severe cyclonic storm over Lakshadweep by Thursday noon.



Health Minister cautions striking doctors

If the striking government doctors do not report for duty on Thursday, it will be considered a break in service, and their posts will be declared vacant. The government will not hesitate to make fresh appointments to these posts through the Medical Services Recruitment Board (MRB), Health Minister C. Vijayabaskar cautioned.

Earlier, Health Secretary Beela Rajesh directed the Directors of Medical Education, Medical and Rural Health Services and Public Health and Preventive Medicine to send necessary circulars to instruct medical officers to return to duty immediately. In the letter, she stated that certain government doctors are on strike from October 25. This was a violation of Rule 22 of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants' Conduct Rules, 1973.

Register wells, borewells by Nov. 10, residents told

Chennai Metrowater has asked residents to register borewells and open wells sunk on their premises on or before November 10 as per the provisions of Chennai Metropolitan Area Ground Water (Regulation) Act, 1987.

Residents may provide details about borewells to the nearby Metrowater office in a prescribed format available with the office, failing which penal action would be taken.

Tamil Nadu Day to be observed tomorrow

Five decades after the State was renamed as Tamil Nadu, the government is gearing up to observe Tamil Nadu Day

– it's formation day – on November 1. This is the first time that the occasion is being observed, after it was announced by Chief Minister Edappadi K. Palaniswami in the Assembly earlier this year.

Kerala sets up panel to sort out water-sharing issues with T.N.

The Kerala government has conveyed to Tamil Nadu the composition of a five-member committee to discuss issues pertaining to the Parambikulam-Aliyar agreement.

Headed by Secretary of the Water Resources Department B. Ashok, the committee includes K.H. Shamsudeen and K.A. Joshy, chief engineers in the Irrigation Department; Sudheer Padikkal, joint director of the Joint Water Regulation Development Board at Palakkad and V.K. Mahanudevan, former chief engineer of the Irrigation Department.

1965 understanding

As per an understanding inked between the two States in 1965, the Pandiyar-Punnampuzha hydro-electric project envisages an average annual generation of 409 million units, by utilising the waters of the two west-flowing rivers. In 1968, the Union Planning Commission gave its nod for the project, about which Kerala subsequently developed second thoughts. Of late, Tamil Nadu has been pressing for at least 7 tmc ft eastward to the State by diverting the two

rivers, flowing within its territorial limits, to the Moyar arm of Bhavani river.

CWRC sitting in Tiruchi on Thursday

This is the first time that the committee is holding a sitting in Tamil Nadu. The committee is expected to take into account the water released from Karnataka reservoirs and the requirements of Tamil Nadu this season.

The committee collects details such as storage, inflows and water levels at the reservoirs in the riparian States and prepares periodical reports on water account in these reservoirs on a monthly and seasonal basis.

NPCIL admits malware attack on computer in Kudankulam nuclear power plant

A day after it denied reports of a cyber attack at the 2,000 MW Kudankulam power plant, the Nuclear Power Corporation of India (NPCIL) on Wednesday said a malware was identified in its system. NPCIL said the malware was noticed on September 4 and investigations by the Department of Atomic Energy revealed that the infected computer was connected to the administrative network. Without naming the power generating station, NPCIL said “the plant systems are not affected”.

“The possibility of a data theft cannot be ruled out and sensitive/confidential information may have got stolen,”

said Sanjay Kaushik, managing director of cybersecurity management firm Netrika Consulting.

Jammu and Kashmir ceases to be a State

The bifurcation of Jammu & Kashmir into two Union Territories came into effect at midnight on October 30. Girish Chandra Murmu and Radha Krishna Mathur will be sworn in as Lieutenant Governors of J&K and Ladakh respectively at two separate ceremonies on October 31.

After nearly two months, HC to get a regular Chief Justice

The Madras High Court is all set to get a regular Chief Justice, after having functioned under an Acting Chief Justice for more than 40 days, though the Supreme Court, in what is popularly known as the Second Judges' Case, had ordered that an "acting arrangement" should not ordinarily exceed more than a month in any of the High Courts in the country.

President Ram Nath Kovind had ordered for the transfer of Chief Justice Amareshwar Pratap Sahi from the Patna High Court to Madras, and had also directed him to take charge on or before November 13.


