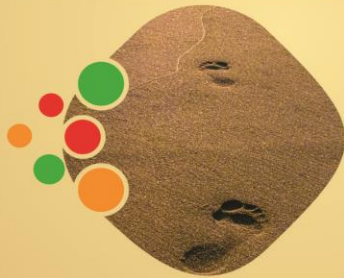

TAMIL NADU

- **Dr J Jayalalithaa University merged with Annamalai University**
 - ✓ The Tamil Nadu government - passed a Bill in the assembly to merge Dr J Jayalalithaa University with Annamalai University.
 - ✓ The DMK's new bill seeks to repeal the Dr J Jayalalithaa University Act 2021.
- **T.N. announces parks for future mobility, apparels**
 - ✓ An integrated apparel park in Virudhunagar district at a cost of 400 crore, a future mobility park in Krishnagiri district at a cost of 300 crore and a SIPCOT Industrial Park in Tiruvallur district, costing 250 crore, were among the major announcements made by the Tamil Nadu government in the Assembly on Tuesday
- **Electoral rolls released for Nine new districts**
 - ✓ Tamil Nadu **State Election Commission** on Tuesday released the electoral roll in nine newly carved districts in the State, ahead of the rural local body polls in those districts.
 - ✓ As per the data provided, the nine districts of **Chengalpattu, Kallakurichi, Kancheepuram, Ranipet, Tenkasi, Tirunelveli, Tirupattur, Vellore** and Villupuram have a total of 76,59,720 voters
- **Chief Minister M K Stalin - announced that Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board will henceforth be known as Tamil Nadu Urban Habitat Development Board**
 - ✓ 'Housing for All' scheme for the urban slum/poor families before 2030
- **Sponge Park**
 - ✓ Greater Chennai Corporation - has proposed to set up a 'sponge park' with artificial pond and rain gardens at the **Kargil Nagar flood water pumping station in Manali zone.**
- **Unique Health ID**
 - ✓ Tamil Nadu government - is planning to provide a unique health ID (UHID) to everyone in the state.
 - ✓ The registry will have the name, age, gender, mobile number, smart (ration) card number, health ID, street details, health sub-centre of the beneficiaries.
 - ✓ The state has already commenced the pilot run of UHID projects in two blocks of Krishnagiri district.
- **The Tamil Nadu Small Industries Corporation Limited (TANSIDCO) - is planning to establish four industrial estates at a cost of Rs. 218.22 crore for MSME units in Tiruvallur, Chengalpatt, Trichy and Madurai district**
 - ✓ Through the Tamil Nadu Startup Seed Grant Fund (TANSEED), the state is also planning to provide a grant of Rs.10 lakh each to 50 startups this year.
- **The Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board - to launch a 'web-based GeoSpatial Services (GSS)' portal to geo-tag industrial polluters in state.**

- **The State government - to set up common effluent treatment plants (CETPs) in 10 locations in Erode and Namakkal districts to prevent discharge of effluents from industries into water bodies.**
- **Blue flag certification**
 - ✓ The Tamil Nadu government - plans to spend Rs.100 crore over the next five years to get the prestigious **Blue Flag certification for the Marina** and nine other beaches in the state.
- **Chief minister of Tamil Nadu - announced a 'manimandapam' (memorial) for the renowned 19th century Tamil scholar Iyothee Thass Pandithar in North Chennai on the sidelines of his 175th birth anniversary**
 - ✓ **Iyothee Thass Pandithar was born as Kathavarayan** in Royapettah in Chennai on May 20, 1845
 - ✓ Out of reverence and affection for his guru, he took the name of Iyothee Thass after his teacher, Iyothee Thaasa Kaviraja Pandithar
 - ✓ His grandfather, Kanthappan handed over palm leaf manuscripts of '**Thirukkural**' and '**Naaladiyar**' to British civil servant Francis Whyte Ellis and helped towards their publication
 - ✓ Iyothee Thass Pandithar. founded the **Advaita Sabha in 1870** with the objective of fighting caste system and '**Dravida Mahajana Sabhai**' in 1891.
- **Celebrations for V.O.C.'s birth anniversary**
 - ✓ Chief Minister M.K. Stalin on Friday made 14 announcements in the Assembly in line with his Independence Day speech that the 150th birth anniversary of freedom fighter **V.O. Chidambaranar** would be celebrated as a government function
 - ✓ The freedom fighter's death anniversary on November 18 would be observed as a '**Day of Sacrifice.**'
- **On September, Tamil Nadu chief minister M K Stalin - announced cancellation of 1% market cess levied on cotton and cotton waste**
- **Chief Minister M K Stalin - presented the Dr Radhakrishnan award to 15 selected teachers out of 389 awardees on September 5**
 - ✓ This year, **Dr Radhakrishnan Award** was conferred to 389 teachers who have excelled in teaching innovation, design for education, environmental improvement, and student enrolment.
- **On September 6, state-run power utility, Tangedco - signed a memorandum of understanding with Indian Renewable Energy Development Agency, a government of India enterprise for mutual collaboration**
 - ✓ Accordingly, TANGEDCO is planning for 20,000 MW of Solar Power Project, 3,000 MW of Pumped Storage Hydro Electric Project, and 2,000 MW of Gas Based Power Plant for efficient **Renewable integration.**
 - ✓ The state government is keen on investing in renewable energy as its own generation from thermal power stations is only 4,320MW, in comparison with the average demand of 15,000MW.

- **Tamil Nadu makes it official: it's workers' right to sit**
 - ✓ It introduces a Bill that makes it mandatory for establishments to provide seating to employees.
 - ✓ It might not have all the connotations of a **Rosa Parks'** protest, but the Bill that the Tamil Nadu government introduced in the Assembly on Monday is revolutionary enough by recognising **workers' "right to sit"**.

- **On September, the state government - announced solar power parks across the state to generate 4,000MW of solar energy with battery storage system of 2,000MW in areas excluding corporations and municipalities.**

- **Chief Minister M K Stalin - to discuss with a business delegation from Denmark on September 8 to explore the possibility of establishing offshore wind mills on the Tamil Nadu coast**
 - ✓ The CoE for off-shore wind energy is most likely to come up in Chennai.
 - ✓ State Industries minister **Thangam Thennarasu** addressed the Danish delegation at a meeting organized by Guidance Tamil Nadu in Chennai on September
 - ✓ Offering Denmark's support to Tamil Nadu, Danish minister for climate, energy and utilities, **Dan Jannik Jorgensen** said Denmark has established itself in green energy, especially wind energy.

- **Tamil Nadu-Denmark plan energy island in Gulf of Mannar**
 - ✓ State of Tamil Nadu and Denmark have planned to create an energy island in **Gulf of Mannar** that lies between the west coast of Sri Lanka and south-eastern tip of India.
 - ✓ This plan was made as Tamil Nadu is looking to expand its footprint in the **green energy sector**.

- **Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M K Stalin - announced in the state Assembly that a civilization flourished on the banks of Thamira barani river 3,200 years ago**
 - ✓ Carbon dating showed paddy found in **burial urn at sivakalai** in Thoothukudi district belonged to 1155 BCE
 - ✓ Thamirabarani river starts in pothigai hills of Western Ghats, flows through Tirunelveli and Thoothukudi districts and empties at korkai (Tirunelveli district into Gulf of Mannar)
 - ✓ The paddy in the urn belonged to 1,155 BCE that is 600 years older than the samples found **in Keeladi in Sivaganga** district where the excavation is ongoing .
 - ✓ According to the historians, the graffiti found in the Indus Valley civilization and in south India are about 80% identical
 - ✓ The state archaeological department is now excavating sites at **Adichanallur, Sivagalai, Korkai, Kodumanal, Mayiladumparai and Gangaikonda Cholapuram**, the CM said.

- **The Tamil Nadu government - has proposed to start excavation at three new sites – Vembakottai in Virudhunagar, Thulukkarpatti in Tiruvelveli and Perumpalai in Dharmapuri district.**

- **'Porunai civilisation is 3,200 years old'**
 - ✓ "The finding has established that the **Porunai river [Thamirabarani] civilisation** dates back to 3,200 years

- **TN Govt. to introduce new cement brand 'Valimai'**
- **TN Govt. to introduce new salt brand 'Neidhal'**
- **Freedom fighter Subramania Bharati's 100th death anniversary**
 - ✓ The CM declared September 11 as **"Mahakavi Day"**, recalling the contributions of the freedom fighter who also advocated equal social rights to all.
- **"Ola Electric" - announced an "all-women" 10,000-strong workforce at its upcoming two-wheeler factory in Pochampalli village of Krishnagiri district in TN**
 - ✓ The **Foxconn** group company has a 25,000 all-women team manufacturing devices and appliances.
 - ✓ Under a specialised **'Project Tejaswini'** initiative, **Hero Motors** has also increased the number of women employees on the shopfloor to more than 1,000
- **Tamil Nadu declares encroachment of temple land as cognizable, non-bailable offence**
 - ✓ The Tamil Nadu Assembly on September 13, 2021, passed a bill that makes the encroachment of properties belonging to religious institutions a cognizable and non-bailable offence.
 - ✓ The bill seeking the amendment of the **Tamil Nadu Religious and Charitable Endowments Act, 1959** was tabled in the assembly on September 13 and was passed unanimously.
 - ✓ The Government of Tamil Nadu has launched a massive drive to retrieve the temple lands that have been encroached in various areas of the State
- **Tamil Nadu Government - to celebrate the birth anniversary of social reformer Periyar E V Ramasamy, September 17, as 'Day of Social Justice' every year**
 - ✓ **Thanthai Periyar**, as he is popularly known, founded the **Dravidar Kazhagam**, a precursor to the ruling Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam (DMK).
 - ✓ The chief minister recalled former chief minister and DMK founder **CN Annaduarai's** 1967 statement in the Assembly that the first DMK government was **"a tribute to Periyar"**.
He also said the **first amendment to the Indian Constitution** came about because of Periyar, who "never went to Parliament
- **95 - Foot - tall statue of social reformer**
 - ✓ The statue will stand on a 40-foot pedestal, altogether making a height of 135 feet from the surface at Trichy (siruganur).
 - ✓
- **KNMT _ Kalaingar Nagarpura Membattu Thittam**
 - ✓ Tamil Nadu government - has launched the **Rs.1,000-crore Kalaingar Nagarpura Membattu Thittam (KNMT)** to fill infrastructure gaps in urban local bodies, especially municipalities and town panchayats.
- **Tamil Nadu and Kerala governments - agreed to set up technical sub-committees to assess the Nirar-Nallar multipurpose straight-cut scheme**
 - ✓ The panel will discuss ways and means to avoid a long circuitous route and convey water from **Upper Nirar to river Nallar**

- ✓ The discussions included building a new dam under **Pandiyar-Punnampuzha** project to divert water to **Noyyal** and **Bhavani** basin in Tamil Nadu.
- **Ravindra Narayan Ravi - was sworn in as the 26th governor of Tamil Nadu on September**
 - ✓ Chief Justice of the Madras **HC, Sanjib Banerjee**, administered the oath of office to him at a ceremony at the Raj Bhavan, Chennai
 - ✓ During the swearing-in event that lasted for 10 minutes, **chief secretary V Irai Anbu** read out '**Warrant of Appointment**' signed by President Ram Nath Kovind on September.
- **Sahitya Akademy Awards**
 - ✓ Two Tamil writers – **TES Raghavan and K Chellappan** – have been chosen for the **Sahitya Akademi prize** for translation for the year 2020.
- **CM lauds winners of Sahitya Akademi**
 - ✓ Chief Minister M.K. Stalin on Saturday commended the winners of the **Sahitya Akademi Prize for Translation**, who has translated Tamil works in other languages and vice versa.
 - ✓ He extended his greetings to **K. Chellappan**, who translated Rabindranath Tagore's Bengali novel **Gora in Tamil**;
 - ✓ **T.E.S. Raghavan**, who translated saint-poet **Thiruvalluvar's Tirukkural in Hindi**
 - ✓ **Sonali Navangul**, who translated Tamil novel **Irاندam Jaamankalin Kathai** by Salma in Marathi.
- **'Silambam recognised by Centre'**
 - ✓ Silambam, an Indian martial art developed by Tamils, has been recognised under the 'Promotion of inclusiveness through sports' initiative of the '**Khelo India**' programme of the Union Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Tamil Nadu Minister for Youth Welfare and Sports Development **Siva V. Meyyanathan** said on Saturday.
- **The state government has decided to make "Silambam", a prehistoric martial art developed in the state, as one of the sporting disciplines eligible for recruitment under 3% sports quota**
- **The Southern Zone Bench of the National Green Tribunal (NGT) - suspends approval to expand Ennore Thermal Power Plant and ordered a public hearing on the proposal.**
- **Two private engineering colleges in Tamil Nadu - have proposed to offer mechanical engineering and computer science engineering courses in Tamil from 2021-22.**
 - ✓ This is the first time since College of Engineering (CEG) in Anna University launched engineering in Tamil 11 years ago.
- **Grantha Script**
 - ✓ A stone inscription with Grantha script and a sculpture - have been discovered near Karuvelampatti in Thiruparankundram union in Madurai district
- **Honour for a Tamil writer after 25 years**
 - ✓ **Indira Parthasarathy**, commonly known as **Ee. Paa**, is **Sahitya Akademi fellow**.

- ✓ After a gap of 25 years, the Sahitya Akademi has chosen a Tamil littérateur – **Indira Parthasarathy**, commonly known as Ee. Paa – for its highest honour of Fellowship.
 - ✓ In 1996, **D. Jayakanthan**, aged 62, was the youngest to become a Fellow of the Akademi. Before him, only two from the Tamil literary world – **Rajaji** or **C. Rajagopalachari (1969)** and **T.P. Meenakshisundaram (1975)**.
 - ✓ Talking of the three previous recipients, he pointed out that Rajaji was known for his elegant Tamil prose. **Meenakshi sundaram** was a “great Tamil scholar and proficient in many languages”.
 - ✓ Jayakanthan was the “first full-fledged creative writer” who was made a Fellow.
- **The Tamil Nadu government - to bear the entire education cost of all government school students joining professional courses under the 7.5% quota**
 - **Schizophrenia Research Foundation (SCARF), India - has established a dedicated facility to cater exclusively to the needs of people with dementia in Chennai.**
 - **The Kovalam beach in Chennai and Eden beach in Puducherry - have been awarded the prestigious “Blue Flag” certification**
 - ✓ India have 10 beaches with the coveted international eco-level tag that is given to clean and well-managed beaches as per globally recognised standards
 - ✓ Eden Beach of Puducherry becomes the first beach in the Union Territory to get the coveted eco label
 - **The Tamil Nadu government - has constituted a four-member special task force (STF) to expedite identification and distribution of land to beneficiaries of the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Gramin) scheme**
 - **Tamil Nadu export promotion policy 2021 in Chennai on September**
 - ✓ The CM urged industries to focus on exports of wide range of GI-tagged products of the state, including Kancheepuram and Arani silk sarees, Thanjavur art works, **Pathamadai** mats, Mahabalipuram stone sculptures, Madurai **jasmine**, Sirumalai **plantains** and Dindigul **locks**, which have demand across the globe.
 - **On September, the State Government - approved one lakh power connections to farmers - most of which would be free -- at a cost of Rs. 3,025 crore to the exchequer**
 - ✓ The one lakh farm electricity connection scheme was recently announced in the State Assembly during the demand for grants (2021-22) for Energy Department.
 - ✓ The state government has entered into an agreement **with Indian Renewable Energy Development Agency Limited (IREDA)** to provide technical expertise in developing renewable energy projects and raise funds to the tune of Rs.1.32 lakh crore
 - **Tamil Nadu government - has identified six champion sectors to focus for the State’s exports thrust**
 - ✓ The champion sectors identified for achieving the \$100 billion target include **automobile and auto components, textiles, food processing, leather and footwear, electronic and communication** as well as machinery.

- **The school education department - is planning to launch a statewide campaign to prevent the learning loss and to ensure basic literacy among children of Classes I to VIII**
 - ✓ Under the campaign, the government plans to take schools to places near students with the assistance of local volunteers to ensure everyone has foundational numeracy and literacy skills.
 - ✓ It will be modelled on the 'Veethi Vagupparai' (Classes on the Streets) method followed by a NGO.
 - ✓ The campaign is likely to be linked with the government's 'Ennum Ezhuthum' mission to ensure children are able to comprehend and possess basic arithmetic skills by the time they reach eight years old.

- **MGR Railway Station of Chennai has become a Green railway fully powered by solar energy.**
 - ✓ **Puratchi Thalaivar Dr. MG Ramachandran Central (DRM)** or Chennai Central railway station will get 100 percent energy through Solar Energy. The Chennai Central railway station comes under the South Central Railway (SCR) zone and which is going to become the world's largest green railway network.

- **Tamil Nadu finance minister Palanivel Thiaga Rajan** - has been nominated by the GST Council in the Group of Ministers (GoM) formed to usher in GST System Reforms

- **Tamil Nadu-based MSME bags contract from Boeing**
 - ✓ For the first time, a Tamil Nadu-based MSME has clinched a deal with the largest aerospace firm Boeing.
 - ✓ Aerospace Engineers Private Limited, located in Salem, won a long-term contract from Boeing to manufacture and supply critical aviation components and parts for the global aerospace company's products.
 - ✓ It will be setting a new manufacturing plant in Hosur.

- **Trans Kitchen**
 - ✓ Trans Kitchen, a hotel run by a group of **transgender people**, was inaugurated near Goripalayam junction, Madurai.
 - ✓ It is a first-of-its-kind initiative in the city.
 - ✓ Swasti organization funded the initiative, in association with organizations like **Aroghyam, Virutti, and Sri Lakshmi Pengal Munnetra Sangam**

- **Defence corridor: T.N. seeks Centre's support**
 - ✓ Tamil Nadu urged the Defence Ministry to sanction six major proposals.
 - ✓ Under the Defence Testing Infrastructure Scheme, the State sought sanction for five proposals – **communication systems & RF antenna in Chennai;**
 - ✓ testing infrastructure for **unmanned aircraft systems in Ulundurpet/Sholavaram;**
 - ✓ a mechanical and material testing facility in Tiruchi;
 - ✓ **electromagnetic interference** and electromagnetic compatibility tests in Chennai; and testing infrastructure for ammunitions in **Tiruchi.**

- **Chief Minister, M K Stalin - inaugurated the Tamil Nadu police museum at Egmore in Chennai on September**

- **Medical Devices Park will attract 3,500 cr. in investments'**
 - ✓ The Medical Devices Park that will come up at Oragadam will attract investments to the tune of 3,500 crore and is expected provide direct and indirect employment to about 10,000 people, Chief Minister M.K. Stalin said on Tuesday
- **Chief Minister M K Stalin - relaunched the 'Varumun Kappom' (preventive healthcare) scheme as 'Kalaigharin Varumun Kappom' at a function at Vazhapadi in Salem on September**
- **The State government - is planning to setup a turmeric research centre in Erode**
 - ✓ This was announced by the commissioner and secretary of Tamil Nadu agriculture and farmers' welfare department C Samayamoorthy.
 - ✓ **Mr.C Samayamoorthy** participated in the third edition of 'PonManjal - CII turmeric conclave 2021' that was organised online by the confederation of India Industry (CII) - Erode zone
- **On September, Chief Minister M K Stalin - introduced a bill in the state assembly to constitute a state commission for scheduled castes (SCs) and scheduled tribes (STs).**

The bill is to be called "The Tamil Nadu State Commission for the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes Act, 2021"
- **The Tamil Nadu government - has increased the quota for women in government jobs from 30% to 40 %**

STATE

- **'My Pad, My Right'** project in Tripura
- **'Merakaam Mera Maan'**
 - ✓ Punjab to Launch 'Mera Kaam Mera Maan' Scheme to Help Unemployed Youth
- **The snow leopard - has been declared the state animal of the Union Territory of Ladakh**
 - ✓ The black-necked crane has been named the state bird of the Union Territory.
 - ✓ The black-necked crane (*Grus nicricollis*) is listed as "near-threatened" on the IUCN Red List of Threatened Species, while the snow leopard (*Panther unica*) is named under "vulnerable" category.
- **The state of Uttarakhand - has decided to deploy women as Gypsy drivers and nature guides across all tiger reserves and wildlife sanctuaries.**
 - ✓ Two tiger reserves in Madhya Pradesh – **Kanha Tiger Reserve-National Park** and the **Pench Tiger Reserve-National Park** – have women guides who accompany tourists to core tiger-inhabited areas.
- **Samagra Sikhsha Abhiyan (SSA)**
 - ✓ Olympian Lovlina Borgohain as the brand ambassador of the Samagra Sikhsha Abhiyan (SSA) in the state of Assam.
- **Telangana - has started a trial run for delivering vaccines by drones on September.**
- **Uttar Pradesh Government launches 'Matra Bhumi Yojana' for the improvement of rural infrastructure**
- **'Katley' declared as state fish of Sikkim**
 - ✓ The Government of Sikkim has declared 'Cooper Mahseer' locally named as 'Katley' as the state fish. *Neolissochilus hexagonolepis* is the scientific name of the Cooper Mahseer
- **The Government of Chhattisgarh - signed MoU with Indian Institute of Millet Research, Hyderabad in the presence of Chief Minister Bhupesh Baghel to launch the 'Millet Mission' in the state**
- **Assam's Rice Wine 'Judima' receives GI Tag**
 - ✓ Assam's traditional **Judima wine** has been awarded the Geographical Indication (GI) tag.
 - ✓ It is made from rice and a certain herb and widely popular among the **Dimasa tribals**.
 - ✓ Judima is inseparable from the social and cultural life of the Dimasas.
 - ✓ This is the second product from the hill districts of Karbi Anglong and **Dima Hasao** to get GI tag after **ginger of Karbi Anglong** was awarded GI tag.
 - ✓ **Judima is the first beverage from the Northeast to get this honour**

- **Pradhan Mantri Kisan Urja Suraksha Evam Utthan Mahaabhiyaan (PM-KUSUM)**, as per the data by the Union Ministry of New and Renewable Energy.
 - ✓ Haryana has installed 14,418 pumps against 15,000 sanctioned pumps for the year 2020-21.
 - ✓ Haryana was given a target of 15,000 pumps for the year 2020-21 with a total cost of Rs 520 crore



NATIONAL

- **India - is the most polluted country in the world, with more than 480 million people or about 40% of its population exposed to pollution**
 - ✓ This was revealed in the annual **Air Quality Life Index** report from the University of Chicago released on September
 - ✓ Delhi is the most impacted state in the entire country, with the average person losing 9.7 years of life as compared to average life expectancy if WHO standards were being met.
 - ✓ Uttar Pradesh is the second ranked state with an average person losing 9.5 years of life.

- **Smog**
 - ✓ Delhi chief minister **Arvind Kejriwal** - inaugurated India's first-ever smog tower at **Baba Kharak Singh Marg** in the Connaught Place recently
 - ✓ Smog towers are structures that are designed as large-scale air purifiers in order to reduce air pollution particles.
 - ✓ **PM2.5** refers to fine particles which penetrate deep into the body and fuel inflammation in the lungs and respiratory tract, leading to risks of cardiovascular and respiratory problems, including a weak immune system.
 - ✓ **"IQAir"**, a Switzerland-based air quality technology company that measures air quality levels of selected cities based on PM2.5 concentration, ranked Delhi the world's most polluted capital for the third straight year in 2020.

- **Centre, Assam government and five Karbi Anglong ultra groups - signed a tripartite peace accord on September**

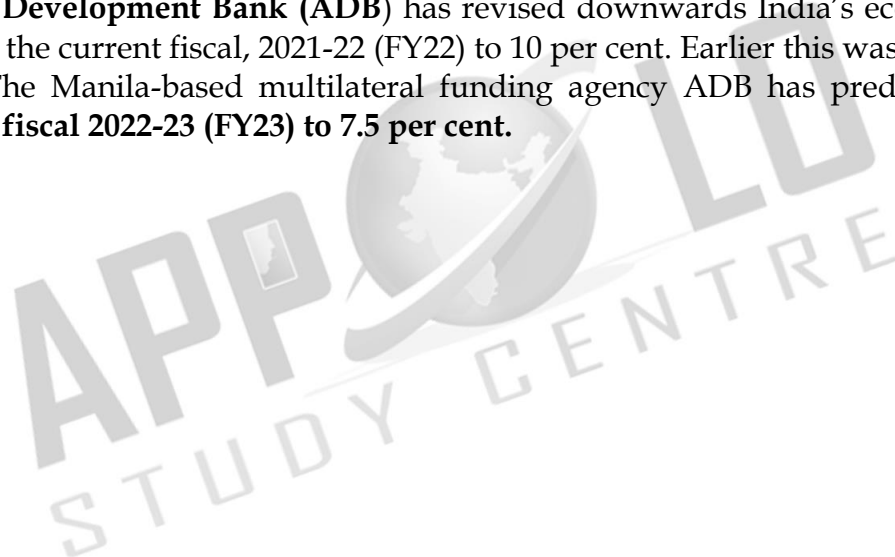

 - ✓ The crew of the Inspiration4, the first-ever orbital flight crewed entirely by tourists, is now officially in orbit, according to a Livestream from SpaceX.
 - ✓ The SpaceX rocket blasted off from NASA's Kennedy Space Center.
 - ✓ The passengers will now spend three days aboard their 13-foot-wide Crew Dragon capsule in orbit at a 350-mile altitude.
- **For the first time in the history of space tourism, Elon Musk's American Aerospace Company, SpaceX - launched the Inspiration4 mission on September**
- **On September 22, the World Health Organisation (WHO) - released its revised air quality guidelines for six key pollutants, making them more stringent compared to the standards set in 2005.**
 - ✓ The government has a dedicated National Clean Air Programme that aims for a 20% to 30% reduction in particulate matter concentrations by 2024 in 122 cities, keeping 2017 as the base year for the comparison of concentration.
 - ✓ These are cities that do not meet the NAAQS when calculated from 2011 to 2015.
- **NASA launches Landsat 9 satellite to monitor Earth's landscape**
 - ✓ NASA successfully launched Landsat 9, a powerful satellite built to monitor the Earth's land surface on 27 September 2021.
 - ✓ Landsat 9, a joint NASA and US Geological Survey (USGS) mission, lifted off on a United Launch Alliance Atlas V rocket from Vandenberg's Space Launch Complex 3E, California.
 - ✓ It will help make science-based decisions on key issues like water use, wildfire impacts, etc.
- **QUAD (Quadrilateral Security Dialogue) Leaders' Summit**
 - ✓ Prime Minister Narendra Modi is set to attend the first-ever in-person QUAD (Quadrilateral Security Dialogue) Leaders' Summit at the White House, in Washington D.C. on September 24, 2021.
 - ✓ Quad nation comprises of India, Japan, the US and Australia. PM Modi will also address the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA)
- **PM Modi had addressed UN General Assembly**
 - ✓ Prime Minister of India Narendra Modi has addressed the 76th session of the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA), in New York.
 - ✓ He is the first world leader scheduled to address the UN General Assembly at 6.30 PM IST. Prior to this, PM Modi had addressed UN General Assembly in 2019.
 - ✓ The theme of the 2021 UN General Assembly session was 'building resilience through hope - to recover from Covid-19, rebuild sustainably, respond to the needs of the planet, respect the rights of people, and revitalise the United Nations.

- The Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Madras is working on developing an innovative digital model to address the problem of e-waste (electronic wastes).
- The Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Bombay has launched 'Project Udaan', a language translator, to break the language barrier in education, which hampers the flow of messages.



SPORTS

- ✓ India finished their campaign at the **Tokyo Paralympics 2020** with an all-time high of 19 medals which includes five gold, eight silver, and six bronze.
- ✓ This is the best medal tally for India a single edition of the Paralympic Games. India is placed at 24th position in the overall medal tally out of a total of 162 nations

➤ Indian Flag Bearers:

- ✓ Javelin thrower **Tek Chand** was the flag bearer at the opening ceremony of the Tokyo Paralympics.
- ✓ Shooter **Avani Lekhara** was India's flag-bearer at the closing ceremony.

➤ India at Paralympics 2020:

- ✓ India sent its biggest ever contingent of **54 para-athletes** at Tokyo Paralympics to compete across as many as 9 sporting disciplines at the Games.
- ✓ Prior to this, India had won a total of **12 Paralympics medals**, since making its first appearance at the Paralympics in 1968, till the 2016 Rio.
- ✓ The Indian theme song of Paralympics 2020 "**Kar de kamaal tu**". The composer and singer of the song is Sanjeev Singh, a Divyang cricket player from Lucknow.

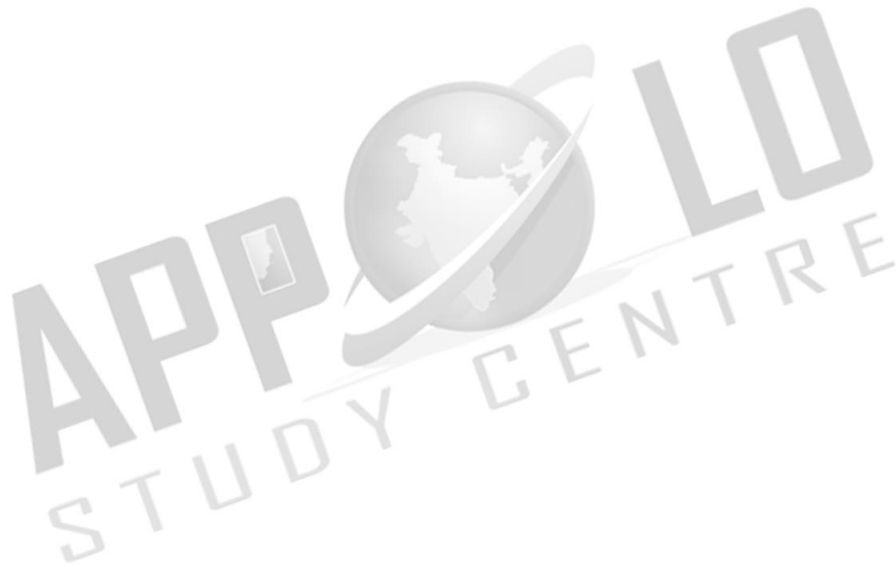
