

TAMIL NADU

- > Tamil Nadu Power Capacity 2024
- ✓ The Tamil Nadu's power generation capacity had increased to 36,671 MW from 32,595 MW.



- ✓ 17,785 km of new high-tension lines and 31,705 km of low-tension lines had been laid.
- ✓ 54 new substations with a total capacity of 2,739 MVA and 46 new 33/11 KV substations had been established.
- ✓ The record-high peak power demand of 20,830 MW on May 2 was met without any hassle.
- ✓ The solar capacity has increased to 8,496 MW.
- > Lok Sabha Election 2024 Tamilnadu



- ✓ The total voter turnout from the total 6,18,90,348 electors in the State was 69.72%.
- ✓ Across all 39 constituencies, Dharmapuri registered the highest turnout of 81.48 per cent turnout.
- ✓ Chennai Central registered the lowest voter turnout of 53.91 per cent.

- ✓ While women voters' turnout stood at 69.85%, the men voter turnout was recorded at 69.58%.
- ✓ DMK and its allies won a spectacular victory in all of Tamil Nadu's 39 segments and in the lone Puducherry seat.
- ✓ Congress candidate and former IAS officer Sasikanth Senthil won with a highest margin of 5,72,155 votes in Tiruvallur.
- ✓ Virudhunagar Lok Sabha constituency's Manickam Tagore of the Congress won with lowest margin of 4379.

DigiYatra Facility

✓ After a long wait, Chennai airport gets DigiYatra facility.



- ✓ In an end to a long wait, the Chennai International Airport on Thursday joined the list of airports in the country that has the DigiYatra facility.
- ✓ DigiYatra, launched two years ago, makes use of the facial recognition technology to facilitate a hassle-free experience for the passengers.
- ✓ Those who want to use the application have to download it on their phone, enter their name, mobile number, Aadhaar and flight details, upload a selfie and create an ID before their trip.

Sustainable Waste Management


✓ To achieve the zero waste goal, the World Bank will support GCC.



- ✓ Assistance will be provided by the World Bank to the Greater Chennai Corporation (GCC) to achieve sustainable waste management in the city.
- ✓ A meeting was held by the World Bank with the state government and GCC officials to discuss solid waste management to prevent garbage dumping in Kodungaiyur by 2026-2027.
- ✓ Various proposals to enhance recycling of solid waste will be implemented after the proposal is passed by the Chennai Corporation Council in the next few months.
- ➤ Over 6,300 Start-ups have come up since 2021 in T.N.
- ✓ A total of 6,384 start-ups have come up since the DMK government assumed office under Chief Minister M.K. Stalin in 2021, the State government said on Monday.



- ✓ Several entrepreneurs from the Adi Dravidar and tribal communities have benefited from the initiative.
- ✓ As of today, the total number of start-ups in the State stands at 8,416.
- ✓ As for women-led start-ups, the number rose from 966 in 2021 to 3,163 start-ups now.
- ✓ The Tamil Nadu Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe Startup Fund has allocated 80 crore.
- Oracle Partners With Tamil Nadu To Empower Youth With IT Skills



- ✓ Oracle has teamed up with the Tamil Nadu Skill Development Corporation to enhance IT skills among the state's youth through the Naan Mudhalvan program.
- ✓ This initiative aims to provide training and certification in cutting-edge technologies like cloud computing, data science, AI, ML, and blockchain, offering employment-linked opportunities to over 200,000 students.

> TN Forms Panel to Prepare Green Logistics Plan for Chennai

- ✓ In a bid to decarbonise the logistics sector by promoting green logistics, the state government has formed a 22-member Chennai City Logistics Coordination Committee headed by special officer of Chennai Unified Metropolitan Transport Authority I Jayakumar as chairperson.
- ✓ The state is preparing a city logistics plan for Chennai and Coimbatore.

 The other important members of the committee include Chennai corporation commissioner, managing director of Tamil Nadu Industrial Development Corporation and managing director of Chennai Metro Rail among others.

New Mangrove Forest

- ✓ The Tamil Nadu Forest Department has planted around 37,500 mangrove propagules over an extent of 25 hectares at Kudikadu village in Cuddalore district.
- ✓ This will be carried out under the Green Tamil Nadu Mission.



- ✓ For the first time, away from the existing mangrove area was identified as the favourable for mangrove plantation.
- ✓ The Rehabilitation of Coastal Habitats scheme is being implemented for another three years from 2023-24 to 2025-26 covering ten districts.

➤ CM Launches Archaeological Excavations in Eight Locations

✓ Chief Minister M.K. Stalin on Tuesday virtually launched archaeological excavations in eight locations across the State.



- ✓ The Chief Minister also released the findings of the Perumbalai excavations and a report on Tamil Nadu Inscriptions Volume XXVIII.
- ✓ The sites are at Keeladi and its cluster (Kondagai) in Sivaganga district; Vembakottai in Virudhunagar district; Kilnamandi in Tiruvannamalai district; Porpanaikottai in Pudukottai district; Tirumalapuram in Tenkasi district; Sennanur in Krishnagiri district; Kongalnagaram in Tiruppur district; and Marungur in Cuddalore district.

> Excavations at Perumbalai

✓ Graffiti marks "resembling geometric symbols" were among the potsherds discovered during the archaeological excavations undertaken by the Tamil Nadu government's Department of Archaeology at Perumbalai in Dharmapuri district.



- ✓ "As per the AMS dates, the lower-most level of the site dates back to the 6th Century BCE.
- ✓ Most of the excavated early historic sites such as Vallam, Kodumanal, Keeladi, Uraiyur, Karur and many other sites always found Tamili (Tamil-Brahmi)-inscribed potsherds and graffiti-bearing potsherds together.

> T.N. registers 12.44% jump in FDI Inflow

- ✓ Tamil Nadu's Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) inflows increased to about \$2.44 billion in the 2023-24 financial year from \$2.17 billion in 2022-23, logging a 12.44% jump, data from the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade under the Union Ministry of Commerce and Industry reveal.
- ✓ Tamil Nadu is among the key States that has seen an increase in FDI inflows, even as overall inflows to India has declined marginally to \$44.42 billion in 2023-24 from \$46.03 billion in 2022-23.

> T.N. to Focus on Technology in Schools

✓ T.N. to focus on technology, AI; schools to get hi-tech, robotics labs: School Education Minister.



- ✓ In a bid to enhance technology access, School Education Minister Anbil Mahesh Poyyamozhi on Monday told the Assembly that 58 crore had been allotted to upgrade the hi-tech labs in government schools.
- ✓ Similarly, 42 crore had been allotted for establishing hitech labs in governmentaided schools.
- ✓ Focus on AI in schools was among the 25 announcements made in the Assembly by the Minister. In the hi-tech labs functioning in government schools, a curriculum would be developed to teach AI, computer science for classes VI-IX.
- ✓ Further, at a cost of 15.43 crore robotics labs would be set up in 38 government high and higher secondary schools for Classes IX-XII.

➤ Anna Centenary Library to House Children's Science Park

✓ The State will construct a children's science park at Anna Centenary Library (ACL) with scientific equipment at a cost of 80.24 lakh to improve scientific knowledge in children.



- ✓ During the demand for grants for the School Education Department in the Legislative Assembly, he said, "The Kalaignar Centenary Library (KCL) in Madurai has seen a footfall of over 9.6 lakh so far since it was opened with over 2,700 people visiting it daily."
- ✓ Under the **Disaithodum Dravidam Project**, translation of Tamil literature and texts will be expanded to include Indian and other foreign languages.

> Tamil Language Martyrs' Day (Tamil Mozhi Thiyagigal Naal)

✓ Minister for Tamil Development, Information and Publicity, M.P. Saminathan, on Monday announced in the Assembly that January 25 would be observed as 'Tamil Mozhi Thiyagigal Naal' (Tamil language martyrs' day) from 2025.



- ✓ Similarly, June 3, which is the birth anniversary of former Chief Minister and DMK president M. Karunanidhi, would be celebrated as 'Semmozhi Naal Vizha'.
- > CM announces Phase Two of Scheme to Improve Rural Roads

- ✓ A total of 10,000 km of roads in rural areas will be improved under the second phase of the Chief Minister's Rural Road Development Programme.
- ✓ Making a suo motu statement, Mr. Stalin said these roads would be improved at a cost of 4,000 crore over the next two years. The first phase of the scheme was introduced by Mr. Stalin in January 2023, with the government announcing the development of 10,000 km of roads in two years at a cost of 4,000 crore.

➤ World Bank-assisted Project for Women - (WE-SAFE)

- ✓ Minister for Youth Welfare and Sports Development Udhayanidhi Stalin unveiled a World Bank-assisted Tamil Nadu Women Employment and Safety Programme (WE-SAFE), which would be implemented in the next five years (2024-29) at a cost of 1,185 crore.
- ✓ The aim is to increase the participation of the women labour force in non-farm and emerging sectors, to achieve a trillion-dollar economy by 2030.
- ✓ "The role of women is important in achieving a trillion-dollar economy.

International Airport to be established at Hosur

- ✓ CM said that the Master Plan for Hosur was nearly complete. Industrial houses across the globe were keen on investing in Tamil Nadu ever since the DMK assumed office in 2021, and the State was witnessing growth in large-scale industries and job opportunities for the youth.
- ✓ "Tamil Nadu topped the country in 2022 in the Export Preparedness Index, and secured the first place in the export of motor vehicles, spare parts, leather, and electronic goods.
- ✓ Tamil Nadu, which was lagging behind in start-ups till 2022, has emerged a major performer in the field and became the second largest economy in the country.

STATE

- > Artificial Intelligence Learning in School Textbooks
- ✓ In a ground-breaking initiative, Kerala has incorporated Artificial Intelligence (AI) learning into the Information & Communication Technology (ICT) textbook for Class 7 students.



- ✓ This program aims to acquaint over 400,000 students with AI in the upcoming academic year, representing a significant advancement in the state's technological education.
- > Uttarakhand Unveils India's First Astro-Tourism Initiative



- ✓ The Uttarakhand government organized India's first-ever astro-tourism event called 'Nakshatra Sabha' in Mussoorie, the 'Queen of Hills', on June 1 and 2, 2024.
- ✓ The inaugural event was held at the George Everest Peak, famous for its breathtaking views of the Doon Valley and the snow-capped Himalayas.
- ➤ India's First UNESCO City of Literature
- ✓ On June 23, 2024, **Kozhikode** made history by becoming the first UNESCO City of Literature in India.





- ✓ This prestigious recognition highlights the city's rich literary heritage and cultural significance.
- ✓ The state government also announced that from coming year, June 23 will be celebrated as the 'City of Literature' Day of Kozhikode, a place known for literary greats like late S K Pottakkad and Vaikom Muhammed Basheer.
- ➤ World's First Asian King Vulture Conservation & Breeding Centre
- ✓ The world's first Asian King Vulture (red-headed vultures) conservation and breeding centre will be set up by Uttar Pradesh in Maharajganj.



- ✓ It will improve the population of the critically endangered species listed on the Red List of the International Union for Conservation of Nature since 2007.
- ✓ The aim of this centre is to ensure the good health of vultures and provide them with a pair.
- ✓ The centre has been named Jatayu Conservation and Breeding Centre, where vultures are being monitored round the clock.
- Srinagar gets Tag of 'World Craft City'
- ✓ Srinagar has become the fourth Indian city to be recognised as a 'World Craft City' by the World Craft Council (WCC), three years after it was designated as part of the UNESCO Creative City Network (UCCN) for crafts and folk arts.



✓ Jaipur, Malappuram and Mysore are the other Indian cities that have previously been recognised as World Craft Cities.



NATIONAL

World Record with 64.2 Crore Voters

✓ Chief Election Commissioner Rajiv Kumar said that India has created a world record with 64.2 crore voters participating in the Lok Sabha Polls.



- ✓ Briefing media in New Delhi, Mr Kumar said that the number is 1.5 times of the voters of all G7 countries US, UK, France, Germany, Italy, Japan and Canada.
- ✓ He said, in this Lok Sabha polls, 31.2 crore women voters cast their votes which is also the highest ever in the world.
- ✓ He also said, only 39 re-polling were conducted in this election unlike 540 repolling in 2019 General Election.

→ 'Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam' Campaign

✓ The Prime Minister, Narendra Modi has launched 'Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam'
Campaign on the occasion of World Environment Day(June 5). Modi's planted a
Peepal tree at Buddha Jayanti Park in Delhi.




✓ He has also urged all to contribute in making our planet better and informed that in the last decade, India has undertaken numerous collective efforts which have led to increased forest cover across the nation.

✓ World Environment Day is celebrated annually on 5 June and encourages awareness and action for the protection of the environment.

'No contest' to NOTA

✓ Indore scripts electoral history in 2024 Lok Sabha election.



- ✓ Indore on June 4 rewrote history by registering the highest-ever NOTA votes in the country at 2,18,674, overtaking a record posted by Bihar's Gopalganj in 2019, while the BJP candidate Shankar Lalwani won the Lok Sabha election from the seat in Madhya Pradesh by a staggering margin of 11,75,092 votes.
- ✓ The NOTA (none of the above) option garnered 16.28 per cent of the total vote cast in the Indore Lok Sabha seat.

> Deep Sea Mission

✓ India is set to join an elite group of nations with the launch of its ambitious Deep Sea Mission, making it the 6th country to embark on such a groundbreaking endeavor.



✓ Dr. Jitendra Singh, Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Science and Technology, Earth Sciences, PMO, Atomic Energy, Space, Personnel, Public Grievances, and Pensions, expressed pride and happiness over the progress of this mission.

Post Office Act 2023

✓ New postal law 'Post Office Act 2023' came into force.



- ✓ A notification was issued by the Central Government making the provisions of the new postal law, Post Office Act, 2023 effective from June 18.
- ✓ It repealed the Indian Post Office Act, 1898." On August 10, 2023, the "Post Office Bill, 2023" was introduced in Rajya Sabha and passed in Rajya Sabha on December 4, 2023.
- ✓ The bill was passed in the Lok Sabha on 18 December 2023.

> India's First Offshore Wind Energy Project

✓ Cabinet approves offshore wind energy projects in Gujarat, Tamil Nadu with a total outlay of Rs 7,453 cr.




- ✓ The Union Cabinet has taken a landmark decision by approving **India's first offshore wind energy project**.
- ✓ These will be 1GW offshore wind projects, 500 MW each (off the coast of Gujarat and Tamil Nadu).
- ✓ The Union Cabinet approved 1 GW offshore wind energy projects in Gujarat and Tamil Nadu with a total outlay of Rs 7,453 crore.

> SIGHT Programme of the National Green Hydrogen Mission (NGHM)

✓ The government enhances allocation for the Fertilizer Sector under the SIGHT Programme of the National Green Hydrogen Mission (NGHM).



- ✓ The Ministry of New & Renewable Energy (MNRE) is implementing the National Green Hydrogen Mission (NGHM) with a target to achieve a production capacity of 5 million tonnes per annum of Green Hydrogen in the country by the year 2030.
- ✓ Under the Mission, MNRE had issued the Scheme Guidelines for implementation of the SIGHT Programme Component II: Incentive for Procurement of Green Ammonia Production (under Mode2A) of the NGHM on 16.01.2024.
- > Public Examinations (Prevention of Unfair Means) Bill, 2024
- ✓ The law to curb irregularities in competitive examinations has come into effect. The law contains provisions for a maximum jail term of 10 years.



- ✓ It also contains provision for a fine of up to 1 crore rupees for offenders. Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha passed the Public Examinations (Prevention of Unfair Means) Bill, 2024, on February 6 and 9, respectively.
- ✓ The bill was given approval by President Droupadi Murmu on February 12 and it became a law.

✓ As per the notification issued by the Department of Personnel and Training (DoPT), the Act has come into force with effect from 21st June 2024.

All-Weather Vadhavan Port

✓ Prime Minister Narendra Modi-led Cabinet has approved the development of greenfield deep draft port at Vadhavan in Maharashtra for Rs 76,200 crore.



- ✓ The port will have nine container terminals, each 1000 meters long, four multipurpose berths, including the coastal berth, four liquid cargo berths, a Ro-Ro berth, and a Coast Guard berth.
- ✓ The port will further aid export and import through the India Middle East Europe Economic Corridor and International North South Transportation Corridor.

➤ India's First Coal Gasification Pilot Project

✓ Ministry of Coal has initiated India's inaugural pilot project for underground coal gasification in Jharkhand. Located at the Kasta coal block in Jamtara District, this innovative venture by Eastern Coalfields Limited aims to transform the coal industry.



✓ Rather than extracting coal, the process will occur underground, converting coal into valuable gases like methane, hydrogen, and carbon monoxide.

✓ These gases can then be used to produce synthetic natural gas, chemical feedstocks, and more, potentially revolutionizing India's energy sector.

➤ Central Civil Services (Leave) Rules

- ✓ Maternity leave for parents of child born through surrogacy.
- ✓ The Centre has notified amended rules to allow women government employees to take 180 days of maternity leave in case they have children through surrogacy.
- ✓ The government has also allowed the "commissioning mother" (the intending mother of the child born through surrogacy) childcare leave and the "commissioning father" paternity leave of 15 days, read the changes made in the Central Civil Services (Leave) Rules, 1972.



SCHEMES

- > Agnipath Scheme
- ✓ The Indian Army has reviewed the Agnipath scheme and made several recommendations.



- ✓ The Indian Army suggested increasing the service period from 4 to 7-8 years.
- ✓ They also recommended increasing the entry age for Agniveers in the technical field to 23 years.
- ✓ It is also recommended that ex-gratia be provided for disabilities during training and that exit management should be handled by a professional agency.
- ✓ It recommended that if an Agniveer dies in war, their family should receive a subsistence allowance.
- ✓ The government launched the Agneepath scheme on June 15, 2022.
- > T.N. Adi Dravidar Housing and Development Corporation's Land Purchase Scheme
- ✓ A total of 191 landless agricultural labourers from Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe communities benefited from the land purchase scheme of Tamil Nadu Adi Dravidar Housing and Development Corporation (TAHDCO) in 2023.



✓ To improve the socioeconomic conditions of landless labourers from SC and ST communities in Tamil Nadu, the State government introduced the land purchase scheme in 2004.

✓ The scheme provides subsidy of maximum 50% of the market value of the land or 5 lakh, whichever is lesser, to each family and for purchasing up to either 2.5 acres of nanjai or five acres of punjai land.

Mannuyir Kaathu Mannuyir Kaappom

✓ Tamil Nadu government launched the 'Chief Minister's Mannuyir Kaathu Mannuyir Kaappom' scheme.



- ✓ The 'Chief Minister's Mannuyir Kaathu Mannuyir Kaappom' scheme was launched by Chief Minister M.K. Stalin to improve soil health.
- ✓ Under this scheme, 20 crore would be spent for the preservation of soil fertility through the use of green manure.
- ✓ A total 206 crore will be spent on the scheme.
- ✓ Green manure seeds will be distributed in the first phase of the scheme in 2024–25.
- > Cabinet Approves National Forensic Infrastructure Enhancement Scheme (NFIES)



✓ The Union Cabinet, under the leadership of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, has sanctioned the Central Sector Scheme titled "National Forensic Infrastructure Enhancement Scheme (NFIES)" with a comprehensive financial allocation of Rs. 2254.43 crore spanning from 2024-25 to 2028-29.

✓ This initiative, spearheaded by the Ministry of Home Affairs, aims to bolster India's forensic capabilities through strategic investments in infrastructure and manpower.

> Nanilam Magalir Nila Udamai Thittam

✓ Nanilam Magalir Nila Udamai Thittam, a new scheme for SC/ST women in Tamilnadu.



- ✓ TN Govt announced in the Assembly that 20 crore would be set aside to enable landless SC/ST women who work as agricultural labourers to buy land.
- ✓ Each eligible candidate can obtain a maximum subsidy of 5 lakh or 50% of the land value.

> Employees' Pension Scheme has been Amended by the Government

✓ The Employees' Pension Scheme (EPS), 1995 was amended by the Government of India to ensure that withdrawal benefits are also available to Employees' Pension Scheme members with less than 6 months of contributory service.



✓ This amendment will benefit more than 7 lakh Employees' Pension Scheme members every year who leave the scheme after less than 6 months of contributory service.

✓ Further, the Central Government has revised Table D and ensured that every full month of service is taken into account for granting proportionate withdrawal benefit to the members. GENTRE

INTERNATIONAL

➤ World's Third-largest Domestic Airline Market



- ✓ India has overtaken Brazil to become the world's third-largest domestic airline market with a 1.55 crore domestic capacity, growing by 11.2% this month.
- ✓ Low-cost carrier IndiGo has driven this growth, doubling its market share to 62% since 2014, and the Mumbai-Delhi route is the eighth busiest globally.
- ✓ In 2014 India was the smallest market with a meager 80 lakh domestic seats.
- > Thailand Approves Same-Sex Marriage in a Historic Move



- ✓ Thailand on Tuesday became the first country in Southeast Asia to legalise samesex marriage, in a historic parliamentary vote hailed as a "victory" by campaigners.
- ✓ The upper house Senate gave final approval by 130 votes to four, with 18 abstentions to changes to the marriage law allowing same-sex couples to tie the knot.

> International Solar Alliance

✓ Paraguay has become the 100th country to join as full member of the International Solar Alliance.




- ✓ External Affairs Ministry said that Paraguay handed over the Instrument of Ratification, during the meeting of Ambassador Fleming Raul Duarte of Paraguay with Head of Depository, Joint Secretary in the Ministry, Abhishek Singh in New Delhi.
- ✓ Initially conceived as a **joint effort by India and France**, ISA was conceptualized during the **21st Conference of Parties** (COP21) in 2015.

CENTRE

INDIA & OTHER COUNTRIES

- ➤ India, Qatar
- ✓ In line with the vision of strengthening investment cooperation between India and Qatar, the first meeting of the Joint Task Force on Investment (JTFI) between the two nations was convened on in New Delhi.



- ✓ The Joint Task Force was co-chaired by Department of Economic Affairs, Secretary, Ajay Seth and the Undersecretary of Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of Qatar Mohamed bin Hassen Al-Malki.
- ✓ The JTFI has underscored the significance of the robust economic relationship between India and Qatar rooted in shared values common objectives and a shared vision for inclusive development.

CONFERENCES & SUMMITS

> G7 Summit

✓ Prime Minister Narendra Modi leaves for Italy to attend the 50th G7 leaders' summit.



- ✓ It will be his first trip abroad after assuming charge as the Prime Minister for the third term.
- ✓ Modi, accompanied by a high-level delegation, will attend an outreach session on the summit on June 14.
- ✓ The session will be focused on issues relating to artificial intelligence, energy, Africa and the Mediterranean.

> International Peace Conference for Ukraine

✓ In Switzerland, an international conference was held at the Burgenstock Resort on Lake Lucerne on 15 June 2024.



- ✓ This conference aimed to lay the groundwork for a peace process in the Ukraine war.
- ✓ The conference was attended by Prime Ministers and other high-ranking representatives from about 100 countries and from international organisations.

- ✓ They discussed issues like grain exports from Ukraine, and humanitarian issues, including prisoner exchanges.
- ✓ India was the only South Asian country that was to attend the peace summit.
- > 112th International Labour Conference
- ✓ 112th International Labour Conference at Geneva, Switzerland.



- ✓ The 112th International Labour Organization (ILC) was held in Geneva from 3-14
 June 2024.
- ✓ It was attended by more than 4,900 delegates representing Governments, and Employers' and Workers' organizations. The 113rd ILC will be held in June 2025.
- **➢** Bonn Climate Conference 2024



- ✓ The mid-year **climate discussions in Bonn**, **Germany**, concluded recently with limited progress, raising concerns for a potentially challenging road ahead to the COP29 summit to be held in Baku, Azerbaijan, later this year.

✓ India has achieved a significant milestone in its defense capabilities with the induction of the indigenous Nagastra-1 kamikaze drones developed by Solar Industries, based in Nagpur.



- ✓ This deployment addresses the critical need for advanced indigenous drone technologies in combat applications.
- ✓ Nagastra-1 is an indigenous kamikaze drone developed by Solar Industries for the Indian Army. It features a 9 kg weight, 30-minute endurance, and a range of up to 30 km in autonomous mode.

> First Multinational Air Exercise Tarang Shakti In August

✓ The Indian Air Force (IAF) is set to make history this August by hosting its firstever multinational air exercise, Tarang Shakti-2024.



✓ The exercise is slated to be held in two phases, with the initial phase commencing in the first two weeks of August in southern India, followed by the second phase in the western sector from late August to mid-September.

> Exercise-HOPEX

✓ Indian Air Force and Egyptian Air Force conducted Exercise-HOPEX to strengthen Defence cooperation.



- ✓ The fourth joint exercise of IAF and EAF held in Egypt from 21 to 26 June.
- ✓ Rafale fighter jets of the Indian Air Force (IAF) participated in Egypt for "Exercise-HOPEX." C-17 Globemaster and IL-78 tankers also participated in the week-long exercise.
- ✓ The exercise aims to promote bilateral and regional cooperation, symbolizing the long-term relations between the two countries.

- ➤ India's GDP Grows 8.2% in FY24 against 7% in FY23
- ✓ According to the provisional estimate of the National Statistical Organization (NSO), the Indian Gross Domestic Product (GDP) grew by 8.2 per cent in the financial year 2023-24.



- ✓ The Indian GDP growth rate in 2022-23 was 7 percent. This is the ninth time since 1960-61 the Indian GDP has grown by 8 per cent or more in a financial year.
- ✓ According to the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, real GDP or GDP at constant prices is estimated to attain a level of over 173 lakh crore rupees in the year 2023-24.
- ➤ GST Collection Rises 10% to Rs 1.73 lakh crore in May
- ✓ The gross <u>Goods and Services Tax</u> revenue for month of May this year stood at 1.73 lakh crore rupees.



- ✓ Ministry of Finance said that this represents a 10% year-on-year growth.
- ✓ Out of the total collection in the month of May, CGST is over 32,000 crore rupees, SGST is over 40,000 crore rupees, IGST is over 87,781 crore rupees and cess is over 12 thousand crore rupees.
- ✓ The gross GST collections in the financial year 2024-25 stood at 3.83 lakh crore rupees. This represents an impressive 11.3% year-on-year growth.

➤ India's Third Largest Export Destination

✓ The Netherlands emerges as India's 3rd largest export destination in 2023-24.



- ✓ The Netherlands has emerged as **India's third largest export destination** after the US and UAE during 2023-24, even as the country's merchandise shipments dipped by over 3%, according to the commerce ministry data.
- ✓ The main commodities which registered healthy export growth in the Netherlands include petroleum products, electrical goods, chemicals, and pharma.
- ✓ India's trade surplus with the Netherlands has increased to \$17.4 billion in the last fiscal from \$13 billion in 2022-23.

✓ India's goods exports have grown 9.1% to \$38.13 billion in May 2024.



✓ The word "neela" signifies the colour blue in most Indian languages—a fitting tribute to the ant's unique colour.

Oleg Kononenko - First Person to Spend 1,000 days in Space

✓ On June 4, Oleg Kononenko achieved the feat, having made five trips to the International Space Station since 2008.



- ✓ On September 15, 2023, his current trip to the ISS began, when he flied into space alongside NASA astronaut Loral O'Hara and his compatriot Nikolai Chub.
- ✓ In February 2024, Kononenko set the cumulative space time record for the first time when he surpassed the record of 878 days, 11 hours, 29 minutes and 48 seconds set by fellow Russian Gennady Padalka in 2015.
- ✓ On September 23, 2024, if Kononenko's mission ends on schedule, it will have spent a total of 1,110 days in orbit.

> Biopharmaceutical Alliance

✓ On June 6, 2024, South Korea, India, the United States, Japan, and the European Union (EU) together launched the Biopharmaceutical Alliance.



- ✓ **Objective:**To put joint efforts into building a resilient supply chain in the biopharmaceutical sector.
- ✓ The inaugural meeting of the Biopharmaceutical Alliance was held in San Diego, California, USA during the Bio International Convention 2024.

✓ The alliance was launched in response to the drug supply shortages experienced during the Covid-19 pandemic.

> Third Reusable Launch Vehicle Landing Experiment

✓ Taking its Reusable Launch Vehicle (RLV) programme one more step closer to reality, the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) is all set to carry out the third and final RLV landing experiment (RLV LEX).



- ✓ The Mission Readiness Review (MRR) cleared the mission for the first half of June, subject to weather conditions, at the Aeronautical Test Range at Chitradurga, Karnataka.
- ✓ "We are scaling up the difficulty level with the third and final mission," Dr. Unnikrishnan Nair said.

➤ Indo-French TRISHNA Mission



✓ Space agency ISRO has announced a joint Indo-French infrared earth observation satellite mission, TRISHNA (Thermal Infra-Red Imaging Satellite for High-Resolution Natural Resource Assessment), to monitor surface temperature and water management around the world.

✓ The goal of TRISHNA is to simplify the Earth's energy and water processes by giving accurate measurements of water stress on land, changes in water quality in coastal and inland bodies of water, and evaluations of urban heat islands.

➤ International Year Of Quantum Science & Technology

✓ United Nations has made a big announcement: 2025 will be the "International Year of Quantum Science and Technology."



- ✓ The goal of this statement is to make more people around the world aware of quantum science and how it can be used through different events all year long.
- ✓ This choice was made after a motion was started by Mexico in May 2023 and backed by nearly 60 countries by November of that same year.

➤ Nitrous Oxide Emitters 2024

✓ India is the world's second largest source of nitrous oxide (N2O).



- ✓ N2O is a greenhouse gas that heats up the atmosphere far more than carbon dioxide.
- ✓ Nearly 11% of such global man-made emissions in 2020 were from India, topped only by China at 16%.
- ✓ The major source of these emissions comes from fertiliser usage.
- ✓ N2O emissions from human activities have increased by 40% (three million metric tons of N2O per year) in the past four decades.

✓ The top three country emitters by volume of anthropogenic N2O emissions in 2020 were China (16.7%), India (10.9%), and the United States (5.7%).

> Aditya-L1



- ✓ Two of the remote sensing payloads aboard India's maiden solar mission, Aditya-L1, have captured images of the sun and its dynamic activities during the solar storm, which occurred in May. Between May 8 and 15, several X-class and M-class flares erupted in the active region AR13664 on the sun.
- ✓ This was associated with coronal mass ejections (CMEs) during May 8 and 9.

> NASA-ISRO Synthetic Aperture Radar

✓ India and the United States (US) are preparing to jointly launch NASA-ISRO Synthetic Aperture Radar to combat climate change and other global challenges.



- ✓ A new partnership between the US Space Force and the Indian startups, 114ai and 3rdiTech.
- ✓ Launching a new partnership between the U.S. Space Force and the Indian startups, 114ai and 3rdiTech, including on advancing space situational awareness, data fusion technologies, and infra-red sensor semiconductor manufacturing.
- > Third and Final 'Pushpak' Reusable Launch Vehicle

✓ Third and final 'Pushpak' reusable launch vehicle landing experiment was successfully carried out by ISRO.



- ✓ On June 23, the Indian Space Research Organisation, ISRO, said that the third and final landing experiment of its reusable launch vehicle 'Pushpak' was successful.
- ✓ RLV LEX-03 (Reusable Launch Vehicle Landing Experiment 3) re-demonstrated autonomous landing capability under more severe wind conditions.
- ➤ Chinese probe returns to Earth with first samples from far side of the moon
- ✓ China's Chang'e 6 probe returned to earth with rock and soil samples from the little-explored far side of the moon in a global first.



✓ "I now declare that the Chang'e 6 Lunar Exploration Mission achieved complete success," Zhang Kejian, Director of the China National Space Administration, said after the landing.



Wildlife Conservationist A.J.T. Johnsingh




- ✓ Noted Indian wildlife biologist and conservationist Asir Jawahar Thomas Johnsingh, popularly known as A.J.T. Johnsingh, died in Bengaluru on Friday after a brief illness. He was 78, and is survived by two sons.
- ✓ His death is a big loss for India's efforts to protect wildlife, especially since
 environmental efforts are already facing a lot of problems.
- > Renowned English Statistician, Frank Duckworth
- ✓ Frank Duckworth, one of the inventors of the Duckworth-Lewis-Stern (DLS) method, passed away. He was 84.



- ✓ The Duckworth-Lewis method, devised by Duckworth and fellow statistician Tony Lewis, was introduced to determine results in rain-affected cricket matches. Lewis had passed away aged 78 in 2020.
- ✓ The method was renamed the Duckworth-Lewis-Stern method after the retirement of Duckworth and Lewis, followed by some modifications by Australian statistician Steven Stern.

REPORT

- ➤ UNESCO State Of Ocean Report 2024
- ✓ UNESCO's 'State of Ocean Report, 2024' provides crucial insights into the current state of global oceans, emphasising the challenges posed by climate change and human activities.



- ✓ The key finding of the report is that the upper 2,000 meters of the oceans have experienced significant warming.
- ✓ Oceans are absorbing about 90% of the Earth's excess energy, causing increased deoxygenation and threatening marine ecosystems and human economies dependent on them.
- ✓ Ocean acidification is on the rise globally. Sea levels have risen consistently since 1993.

RANKING

- Global Gender Gap Index 2024
- ✓ India has slipped two places to rank 129th on the World Economic Forum's (WEF) Global Gender Gap index, while Iceland retained its top position in the rankings published on June 12.



- ✓ Within South Asia, India was ranked fifth after Bangladesh, Nepal, Sri Lanka, and Bhutan, while Pakistan was ranked last. Iceland was followed by Finland, Norway, New Zealand, and Sweden in the top five, while the U.K. was ranked 14th, and the USA was at 43rd place.
- > India's Environment Performance in 2024



- ✓ India's latest ranking in the Environmental Performance Index (EPI) for 2024 places it at 176th out of 180 countries, reflecting slight improvement from previous years but still positioning it among the world's lowest performers.
- ✓ The index, prepared by Yale and Columbia universities, highlights India's struggles in crucial areas like air quality, biodiversity, and greenhouse gas emissions.

Global Energy Transition Index



- ✓ According to the Global Energy Transition Index released by the World Economic Forum (WEF) on 19 June 2024, India has been ranked 63rd out of 120 countries, improving three ranks from last year's 67th position.
- ✓ Sweden has again topped the Index, reflecting its continued leadership in energy transition. The WEF highlighted India's significant advancements in energy equity, security, and sustainability.

> IMF Artificial Intelligence Preparedness Index 2024

✓ The IMF released an Artificial Intelligence Preparedness Index Dashboard tracking 174 economies globally for AI readiness.



- ✓ The Index ranks India at the 72nd position, with Bangladesh (0.38) at 113, Sri Lanka (0.43) at 92, and China (0.63) at 31.
- ✓ Singapore (0.80), Denmark (0.78), and the United States (0.77) are among the highest-rated AEs, with India categorized as an EM with a 0.49 rating.

Energy Transition Index

✓ India ranked at 67th place on Energy Transition Index.



- ✓ The World Economic Forum released Energy Transition Index on 28th June.
- ✓ Sweden is on the top of the Energy Transition Index 2023.
- ✓ Denmark, Norway, Finland and Switzerland are in the top five of the ranking.
- ✓ As per the report, India is the only major economy that has accelerated across equitable, secure and sustainable dimensions of the Energy Transition Index.
