- ✓ The Dakar 2023 Joint Declaration on Climate Change outlines the expectations and priorities of the least developed countries for the 28th Conference of the Parties (COP28) to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change.
- ✓ IPCC AR6 conclusions: Ministers highlighted the conclusions of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change's Sixth Assessment Report Cycle (IPCC AR6) summary report, which shows that global greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions have continued to increase and global warming is fast approaching 1.5°C.
