Shreshta Scheme

✓ Government Introduces Shreshta Scheme For Quality Education Of Scheduled Caste Students.



- ✓ In a remarkable move towards enhancing education and bolstering the socioeconomic advancement of Scheduled Caste (SC) students, the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment has unveiled the 'Scheme for Residential Education for Students in High Schools in Targeted Areas' (SHRESHTA).
- ✓ SHRESHTA, designed to provide high-quality education to SC students, aims to create an environment conducive to their holistic development and secure their future prospects.

> Samadhan Scheme

✓ The Tamil Nadu government on Tuesday announced a new Samadhan scheme
with waivers and concessions to pave the way for the settlement of the pending
tax dues of about 25,000 crore, of which a majority are under the erstwhile Tamil
Nadu Value Added Tax and other legacy tax legislations.

- > 16th Agricultural Science Congress
- ✓ The 16th Agricultural Science Congress in Kerala will get underway this afternoon in Kochi. Parshottam Rupala, Union Minister for Fisheries, Animal Husbandry, and Dairy, will open the four-day celebration.



- ✓ Renowned agricultural economists, scientists, policymakers, farmers, and entrepreneurs will be gathered at the Congress, which will serve as a forum for them to interact and share ideas.
- ✓ The National Academy of Agricultural Sciences' main goal in hosting the meeting
 is to foster a scholarly conversation about transforming India's agri-food systems
 into sustainable businesses so that future generations can profit from it.
- > 8th BRICS International Competition Conference
- ✓ The Competition Commission of India (CCI) is hosting the 8th BRICS International Competition Conference in New Delhi from October 11-13, 2023.



- ✓ The conference will focus on "New Issues in Competition Law and Policy –
 Dimensions, Perspectives, Challenges".
- ✓ The conference aims to discuss emerging issues and challenges in competition enforcement in BRICS countries.

> 9th P20 Summit: New Delhi

✓ Presiding Officers of Parliaments of several G20 member countries have started arriving in New Delhi to take part in the ninth Parliamentary Speakers' Summit (P20 Summit).



- ✓ Presiding Officers of the Pan African Parliaments will be participating in the P-20 Summit in India for the first time.
- ✓ Prime Minister Narendra Modi will inaugurate the Summit on 13th of October.

IMPORTANT DAYS

Nilgiri Tahr Day – October 07

✓ Nearly a year after launching the Project Nilgiri Tahr for the conservation of its State animal, Tamil Nadu will celebrate the first 'Nilgiri Tahr Day' on October 7 (Saturday).



- ✓ October 7 was chosen by the Government as Nilgiri Tahr Day in honour of E.R.C. Davidar, a wildlife conservationist who pioneered studies on the sole mountain ungulate of Southern India as early as in 1960s.
- ✓ While launching Project Nilgiri Tahr, the Government had declared that Davidar's birthday would be celebrated as Nilgiri Tahr Day.
- ✓ Davidar took the first census of the Nilgiri tahr in the Nilgiris landscape during 1963.
- International Day Of The Girl Child October 11
- ✓ The International Day of the Girl, observed every year on October 11, is a
 global initiative dedicated to raising awareness about gender inequality and
 advocating for the rights and empowerment of girls.



- ✓ The International Day of the Girl was first celebrated in 2012.
- ✓ This day was established to focus attention on the unique challenges girls face and to promote their empowerment and the fulfillment of their human rights.
- ✓ The day was born out of the recognition that girls, like boys, deserve equal opportunities and rights.
- ✓ The theme for the International Day of the Girl in 2023 is "Invest in Girls' Rights: Our Leadership, Our Well-being."
