- ✓ The global theme for the 16 Days of Activism against Gender-based Violence in 2023 is a powerful call to action: "UNITE! Invest to prevent violence against women and girls."

- World's Biggest Iceberg On The Move After 30 Years
- ✓ The world's largest iceberg, named A23a, has embarked on a rare journey after being largely stationary for more than three decades.



- ✓ Weighing nearly a trillion metric tonnes and spanning an area of 4,000 square km, this colossal iceberg originated from West Antarctica's Filchner-Ronne Ice Shelf in 1986.
- ✓ For the first time in more than 30 years, A23a is on the move. Strong winds and ocean currents are propelling it past the northern tip of the Antarctic Peninsula.
