

## **OBITUARY**


- > Dr. Nitya Anand
- ✓ Dr Nitya Anand, who discovered India's first oral contraceptive pill 'Saheli', passed away at the age of 99.



- ✓ Anand was also the former director of the Central Drug Research Institute (CDRI) from 1974 to 1984.
- ✓ He was the brain behind the discovery of Centchroman', popularly known as 'Saheli.' It was the world's first and only non-steroidal, non-hormonal, once-aweek oral contraceptive pill.
- ✓ It was launched by then Prime Minister Rajiv Gandhi in 1986.
- ✓ In 2016, Saheli was incorporated in the National Family Programme of India.

- ➤ Martyrs Day Or Shaheed Diwas: January 30
- ✓ India commemorates Martyrs' Day, also known as Shaheed Diwas, on January 30th each year.
