- ✓ This recognition will be formally presented during the 142nd IOC Session in Paris on August 10, 2024, a day before the closing of the Paris Olympics.
- ✓ The Olympic Order, the IOC's highest award, acknowledges distinguished contributions to the Olympic Movement.

➤ India's National Flag Day – July 22
